Fall Wrapped Up



Like wrapping up in your favorite blanket on a cool day, but so stylish you don't need to leave it on the sofa when you leave the house.

Yarn:

Misti Alpaca Hand Paint Chunky Landscape Collection 6 skeins

Approximate Finished Size After Blocking: 12" from inner edge to outer edge

Inner Edge: 59" Outer Edge: 126"

Gauge:

16 stitches equal 4" in stockinette on size 10 needles or adjust needle size to obtain gauge.

Supplies:

1 pair size 10 needles (or size needed to obtain gauge), 3 stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle

Directions:

CO 50 Stitches

Note: Slip first stitch of every row that begins at the outer edge of the garment purl-wise holding yarn in back of needle if next stitch is a knit, and holding yarn in front of the needle if the next stitch is a purl (do not slip when turning short rows).

Rows 1 and 2: Follow chart

Row 3: Sl1, K4, P2, K4, P2, place marker, K4, P2, place marker, K6, P2, K6, P2, place marker, K4, P2, K9 Rows 4-24: Follow chart

Repeat rows 4-24 28 more times. On last repeat, end at row 20 and finish with 2 rows of K1, P1 rib.

Bind off all stitches.

Weave in loose ends.


Block to size.







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By following these hints, the turns of the short rows will be hidden in the purl "ditches" between cables.

All wraps and turns for short rows begin on WS rows.

Beginning on row 6 (WS), follow chart to the last marker. Slip the marker, move working yarn to the RS of work, slip the next stitch, move working yarn back to the WS, slip the stitch back to the left hand needle and turn the work. Slip the marker and follow the chart to complete the row. Repeat with the middle and first markers.

On row 12, follow chart to the first marker, slip marker, pick up the yarn that was wrapped and knit together with the stitch that had been wrapped. Move working yarn to the WS, slip the next stitch, move the working yarn to the RS and turn the work. Purl the next stitch on the left hand needle, slip the marker then follow the chart to complete the row. Repeat with the middle and last markers. When you come to these wrapped stitches again, pick up the yarn that was wrapped and knit together with the stitch that had been wrapped.

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
