

Kidsilk Haze Circular Scarf Knitting Pattern

For Jimmy Beans Wool (<http://jimmybeanswool.com>)

I was inspired to knit this scarf by Ann Norling - though not a published pattern, she had knit one for herself and let me borrow it one afternoon when i was freezing to death. The scarf was knit in 5" sections... 1 section for each color, repeated twice. Naturally, the scarf is 60" long, but I've blocked the heck out of it and made it about 25% longer!

Materials

Quite a few of the original colors as seen in the photo on the patterns page have since been discontinued (they were 584, 626, 641, 589, 592, 640; in order), so this is the new list of colors:

Rowan Kidsilk Haze, 1 ball each of (in order): 668, 590, 641, 589, 667 and 639.

US 6 16" needles

Gauge / Size

Gauge 5 sts/inch blocked

Approximate Finished Size - 60" Long

Abbreviations

K - Knit

st. st. - stockinette stitch

Directions

Using US 6 Needles and the first color, cast on 100 stitches.

Join into the round and knit for 5 inches.

Change to the next color and knit for 5 inches.

Continue working through all of the colors, knitting with each color for about 5 inches.

Repeat the color sequence one more time.

Bind off and block to desired length and width.
