Kidsilk Haze Circular Scarf Designed by: Laura Zander For Jimmy Beans Wool

I was inspired to knit this scarf by <u>Ann Norling</u> - though not a published pattern, she had knit one for herself and let me borrow it one afternoon when i was freezing to death. The scarf was knit in 5" sections... 1 section for each color, repeated twice. Naturally, the scarf is 60" long, but I've blocked the heck out of it and made it about 25% longer!



Specifications

Quite a few of the original colors as seen in the photo above have since been discontinued (they were 584, 626, 641, 589, 592, 640, in order), so this is the new list of colors:

- Rowan Kidsilk Haze, 1 ball each of (in order): 668, 590, 641, 589, 667 and 639.
- US 6 16" needles

Gauge / Size

- Gauge 5 sts/inch blocked
- Approximate Finished Size 60" Long

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Abbreviations

- K Knit
- st. st. stockinette stitch

Directions

- Using US 6 Needles and the first color, cast on 100 stitches.
- Join into the round and knit for 5 inches.
- Change to the next color and knit for 5 inches.
- Continue working through all of the colors, knitting with each color for about 5 inches.
- Repeat the color sequence one more time.
- Bind off and block to desired length and width.

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
