Elfin Sparkle Sood!

knitted flat on circular needles

You'll need:

4 balls of Lumio yarn [three colors recommended (2 green,1 orange,1 blue were used in model)]

US size 15, 24" circular needles

Crochet hook



Green = color 1

Orange = color 2

Blue = color 3

k = knit stitch, stockinette stitch

p = purl stitch

ktbl = knit through the back loop, twisted stockinette stitch

In color 2, cast on 16 stitches.

[k1, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k1] 6 rows.

Switch to color 1

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1, k1] 11 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k3, ktbl2, k3, p1, k1, p1, k1] 8 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k3, ktbl2, k3, p1, k1, p1, k1] 8 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1, k1] 17 rows

increase 6

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, (p1, k1.. 5 times)] 4 rows

increase 5

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, (p1, k1.. 7 times), k1] 4 rows

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k23] 4 rows

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k23] 4 rows

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k23] 4 rows

increase 4

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k27] 6 rows

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k27] 6 rows

increase 4

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k31] 6 rows

increase 4

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k35] 4 rows

increase 2

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k37] 2 rows

decrease 2

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k35] 4 rows

decrease 4

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k31] 6 rows

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k27] 6 rows

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k27] 6 rows

decrease 4

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k23] 4 rows

change to color 3

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k23] 4 rows

change to color 2

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k23] 4 rows

change to color 1

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, (p1, k1.. 7 times), k1] 4 rows

decrease 5

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, (p1, k1.. 5 times)] 4 rows

decrease 6

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1, k1] 17 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k3, ktbl2, k3, p1, k1, p1, k1] 8 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1, k1] 44 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k3, ktbl2, k3, p1, k1, p1, k1] 8 rows

[k1, p1, k1, p1, k8, p1, k1, p1, k1] 11 rows

switch to color 2

[k1, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k2, p2, k1] 6 rows

cast off

In the gaps where you did ktbl, finger knit with color 2 making a nice contrasting slits of color.

Fold right side in and join the triangular hood area together using the crochet hook and color 1.

Flip it right side out and push the point of the hood out as far as you can. It should be rather stiff and shapable.

This pattern creates an inverted brim on the hood that is fun to shape, you may also substitute the k1, p1, k1, p1 border for a garter stitch border that will stay flat (k all even rows and p all odd rows), this can be done purely on the hood [the stripes of color 2 and 3] or on the hood and scarf. As written the scarf will fold itself in thirds.

I have yet to find the perfect bells to attach to the point of my hood, but that is definitely in it's future, you could also attach a Pom Pom there or leave it naked. ;)

WArmies

knitted in the round

You'll need:

The leftover yarn from the Scood above. (I got to the last few inches of blue on mine, so don't worry if it looks like you'll run out, even if you do, this is a festival/Burning Man garment and the more unique it is, the better!)

US size 13, 16" circular needles

Crochet hook

Green = color 1

Orange = color 2

Blue = color 3

k = knit stitch, stockinette stitch

p = purl stitch

Mock Rib stitch = [row 1: k all stitches, row 2: knit 1 *with yarn in back, slip the next 2 stitches as if to knit, purl 1*], continue the stitch naturally when you switch colors and are adding the thumbhole.



In color 3

Cast on 24

k one row

kk, pp one row

Mock Rib stitch 15 rows

change to color 1

Mock Rib stitch for 3 rows

create a button hole [thumbhole] by going back and forth [rather than around] with Mock Rib stitch 4 times

Mock Rib stitch for 3 rows

p one row

cast off using color 2 for contrast.

Repeat to make second WArmie.
