

Jimmy Beans for Brains Scholarship

Application for all Categories: 2010-2011 Award Year

The Jimmy Beans for Brains undergraduate scholarships are open to all persons attending an accredited four-year institution in the fall of 2010. Applicants do not need to know what school they plan to attend in order to apply, but must submit proof of enrollment at their chosen school before funds are awarded. Applicants must be pursuing a degree, but the desired degree may be in any field.

Each scholarship awarded will be in the amount of \$800.00, four in the General category (one for each U.S. Region*), and one in the Reno/Tahoe Locals category. Only residents of the Reno/Tahoe area may apply for the Reno/Tahoe Locals scholarship; those applying for the Reno/Tahoe Locals category will also be eligible for the General category (the Western Region), though no applicant will be awarded more than one scholarship. Awards will be merit based and applications will be judged on GPA, extracurricular activities, and essay quality.

In addition to the \$800 scholarship, winners will also receive a 1 year subscription to Vogue Knitting International, as well as a \$25 VogueKnitting.com gift certificate.

Application Instructions:

- Applications will be accepted September 30, 2009 through March 31th, 2010.

Additional Requirements:

- Applicant must be a knitter or crocheter and must submit a photo of their latest project.
- Winners must provide one of the following:
 - Photo and written directions for an original pattern. Vogue Knitting reserves the right to publish the pattern and photo in a future issue of Vogue Knitting International.
 - Photo and description of a project created out of an issue of Vogue Knitting International.
- Winners must provide the following personal information: hometown, school/major, and personal photo. Vogue Knitting reserves the right to publish the winner's name, photo, hometown, school and major in a future issue of Vogue Knitting or one of its other publications.
