Be swept away by Crete. The fluid drape of this bias-knit scarf is a graceful accent to any outfit.

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED DIMENSIONS

12" width
70" length

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

MATERIALS

Shibui Knits Birch
100% Extra Fine Merino
262 yds / 50 g
3 skeins

Shibui Knits Lunar
60% Extra Fine Merino,
40% Mulberry Silk
401 yds / 50 g
1 skein

Shown in Limited Edition Color: Ember

GAUGE

16 sts & 20 rows = 4" in St st after blocking,
with 1 strand of Lunar and 1 strand of
Birch held together, on size 9 needles or
size needed to obtain gauge

TOOLS

Size 9 (5.5 mm) needles
Blocking wires (recommended)
Tapestry needle

NOTES

Crete is knit on the bias with 1 strand of
Lunar and 1 strand of Birch held together.
Scarf begins and ends with sections knit
with 1 strand of Birch.

CRETE SUMMER VERSION

DIRECTIONS

With one strand of Birch, CO 60 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K2, ssk, k to 2 sts before end of row, M1 (see Techniques), k2.

Rep rows 1 & 2 until piece measures 10", ending with a WS row. Measure along sides from CO edge (see schematic).

Join one strand of Lunar. With one strand of Lunar held tog with one strand of Birch, cont working as established until piece measures 60".

Drop strand of Lunar. Work 10" with Birch only.
BO all sts.

FINISHING

Block to measurements. Blocking wires are recommended to obtain straight edges.

Weave in ends.

TECHNIQUES

M1

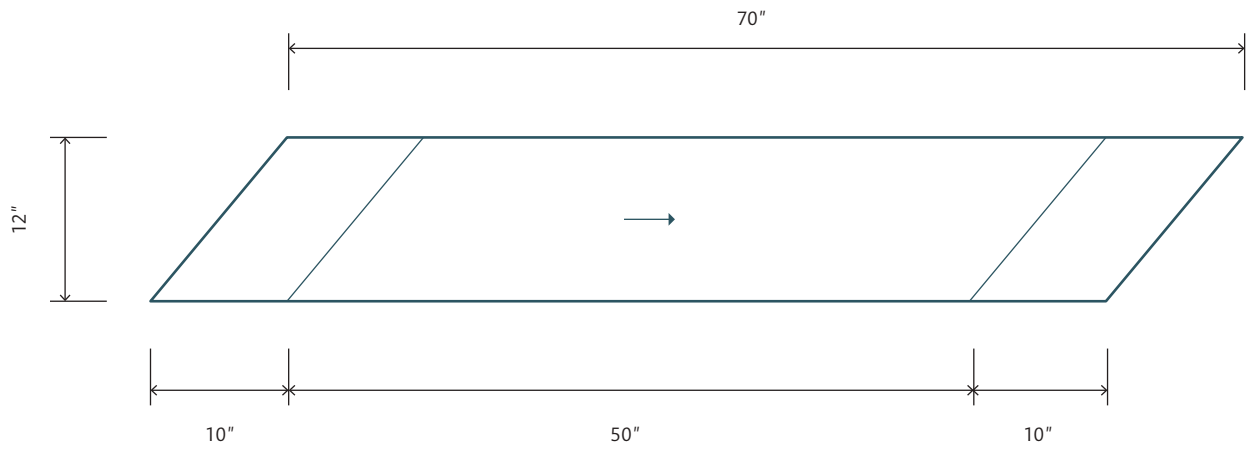
Insert the LH ndl, from front to back, under the strand of yarn which runs between the st just worked and the next st on the LH ndl. Knit the strand through the back loop.
1 st inc'd.
