We did something really special for our 2020 Blanket Club! Each month, we had our own team of in-house expert knitters and crocheters (Team Jimmy Beans, aka The Beans!) design their own beanies, hats, toques, and other yarny head warmers. During the year, those patterns were exclusive to Blanket Club subscribers. Imagine that! Twenty-four brand new and exciting hat patterns, on top of the already awesome blanket pattern! It was the deal of the century! Well, by popular request, we have collected all of those patterns here, for your maker-tainment.

Please note, these hat patterns were originally designed to use Hedgehog Fibers Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool, 100 grams/182 yards). That yarn base was exclusive to our Blanket Club, and we no longer stock it. Some good alternatives include:

- Malabrigo Rios (100% superwash merino wool, 100 grams/210 yards)
- Madelinetosh Vintage (100% superwash merino wool, 100 grams/200 yards)
- Lorna's Laces Shepherd Worsted (100% superwash wool, 113 grams/225 yards)

Some of Team Beans are experts, for whom designing is old hat (ha!), while others are just beginning to spread their designer wings. We hope you enjoy these patterns, and have as much fun making them as we had designing them!



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Knit Abbreviations

c3/3L – slip 3 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front, k3, k3 from cable needle
 c3/3R – slip 3 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back, k3, k3 from cable needle
 CO - cast on
 dec'd – decreased
 Inc'd - increased
 k – knit
 k1tbl – knit 1 stitch through the back loop
 K2tog - knit 2 stitches together
 K3tog - knit 3 stitches together
 M1 - make one stitch

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Lotus Hat

Beanies by Beans #1

Size

Teen/Adult Small (Adult Medium, Adult Large)
Finished Circumference: 16 (18.75, 21.25)"

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular & set of dpns; US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 2" pom-pom maker (optional, see notes)

Gauge

18 sts x 24 rnds = 4" in stockinette stitch

Pattern Notes

This hat is knit in the round from the brim up. The largest size may not have enough yarn leftover for a 2" pom-pom. You could make a smaller pom-pom for this size, leave it off, or go stash diving!

Pattern:

Brim

With smaller needle, cast on 72 (84, 96) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-10: [K1 tbl, p1] to end.

Hat Body

Switch to larger needle. Follow written instructions below, or charted instructions on next page.

Rnd 1: * K1 tbl, p1, k1 tbl, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, [k1 tbl, p1] 2 times; rep from * to end. Pattern will be repeated 6 (7, 8) times across each rnd.

Rnd 2: * K1 tbl, p1, k2tog, yo, p3, yo, ssk, p1, k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: * K1 tbl, k2tog, yo, p5, yo, ssk, k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 4: * K1 tbl, p9, k1 tbl, p1; rep from * to end.



Rnd 5: * K2tog, yo, p9, yo, ssk, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 6: * K1, p9, k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: * Ssk, p3, yo, p1, yo, p3, k2tog, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 8: * K1, p9, k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnds 9-12: Rep Rnds 7-8, 2 times.

Rnd 13: * Yo, ssk, p7, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 14: * K2, p7, k3; rep from * to end.

Rnd 15: * K1, yo, ssk, p5, k2tog, yo, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 16: * K3, p5, k4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 17: * K2, yo, ssk, p3, k2tog, yo, k3; rep from * to end.

Rnd 18: * K3, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, k4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 19: * K4, yo, k3tog, yo, k5; rep from * to end.

Work even in stockinette stitch (knit every rnd) until piece measures 6.25" from cast-on edge.

Shape Crown

Set-up Rnd: * K12, pm; rep from * to end.

Rnd 1: Knit to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * to end

- 6 (7, 8) sts dec'd, 60 (70, 80) sts remain.

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Lotus Hat

Beanies by Beans #2
by Adrienne Anila

Size

Adult Small (Adult Medium/Large)
Finished Circumference: 18.75" (21.25")

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100%
superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1
skein

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm)

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 2"
pom-pom maker (optional, see notes)

Gauge

15 dc x 8 dc rows = 4"

Pattern Notes

This hat is worked from the top down in a
spiral. The largest size may not have enough
yarn leftover for a 2" pom-pom. You could make
a smaller pom-pom for this size, leave it off, or
go stash diving!

Special Abbreviations

FPHT: front post half-treble crochet (yarn over
hook twice, insert hook around front of next
post, yarn over hook, pull through two loops,
yarn over, pull through remaining three loops)
FPDC: DC through front post of next st
BPDC: DC through back post of next st

Pattern:

Use the magic ring and make 10 sc in ring. Pull
tight and join with sl st.

Crown Increases

Rnd 1: Ch 2, dc in same st. 2 dc in each st
around (20 dc).

Do not join.

Rnd 2: 2 dc in ch 2, 1 dc in next st, *2 dc in next
st, 1 dc in next st* repeat between ** around
(30 dc)



Rnd 3: *2 dc in first st, 1 dc in each of next two
sts* repeat between ** around (40 dc)

Rnd 4: *2 dc in first st, 1 dc in each of next 3 sts*
repeat between ** around (50 dc)

Rnd 5: *2 dc in 1st st, 1 dc in each of next 4 sts*
repeat between ** around (60 dc)

Rnd 6: *2 dc in 1st st, 1 dc in each of next 5 sts*
repeat between ** around (70 dc)

Adult Medium/Large Size only:

Rnd 7: *2 dc in 1st st, 1 dc in each of next 6 sts*
repeat between ** around (80 sts)

Hat Body:

All Sizes:

Rnds 1-4: 1 dc in each st around.

Rnd 5: *1 dc in each of next 4 sts, FPHT in next
st, FPHT in next st, 1 dc in each of next 4 sts*
repeat between ** around.

Rnd 6: *1 dc in each of next 3 sts, FPHT, dc, dc,
FPHT, dc, dc, dc* repeat between ** around.

Rnd 7: *Dc, dc, FPHT, dc, dc, dc, dc, FPHT, dc,
dc* repeat between ** around.

Rnd 8: *Dc, FPHT, dc, dc, dc, ch 1, skip next st,
dc, dc, FPHT, dc* repeat between ** around.

Rnd 9: *Dc, dc, FPHT, dc, dc, dc, dc, FPHT, dc,
dc* repeat between ** around.

Rnd 10: *Dc, dc, dc, FPHT, dc, dc, FPHT, dc, dc,





dc* repeat between * * around.

Rnd 11: Repeat Rnd 5.

Rnds 12 -13: Ribbing- *FPDC, BPDC* repeat between * * around.

Join to top of 1st st with sl st. Fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Make a pom-pom and sew to top of hat.





Ripples Hat

Beanies by Beans #3
by Sarah Krutz

Size

One Size
Finished Circumference: Fits 21-22" head

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein
Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular & set of dpns
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

Gauge

21 sts x 24 rounds = 4" in pattern, unblocked/unstretched

Pattern Notes

This hat is knit in the round from the brim up. The pattern will look very small when knitting, but stretches easily to fit teen and adult heads!

Pattern:

Brim

Using circular needle, loosely cast on 75 sts.
Join to knit in the rnd, pm for beginning of rnd.

Rnd 1: *K1, p1, k1* around.

Repeat Rnd 1 until brim measures 1.5", or desired length.

Next rnd: *[K1, p1, k1] 5 times, pm* around.

Hat Body

Follow written instructions below, or the Ripples Chart.

Rnd 1: *K2, p1, k3, p3, k3, p1, k2, sm*. Repeat * to * around, 5 times.

Rnd 2: *K1, p1, k1, p1, k2, p3, k2, p1, k1, p1, k1, sm*. Repeat * to * around.

Rnds 3 & 4: Repeat Rnds 1 & 2, 1 time.

Rnd 5: *K1, p3, k3, p1, k3, p3, k1, sm* around.



Rnd 6: *K1, p3, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p3, k1, sm* around.

Rnds 7 & 8: Repeat Rnds 5 & 6, 1 time.

Repeat rnds 1-8, 4 times, until work measures 6.5" from cast on edge, or desired length.

Crown Shaping

Note: Switch to dpns when there are too few sts to fit on the circular needle.

Dec rnd: *SSK, work in established pattern to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm* around - 10 sts dec'd, 65 sts remain.

Pattern rnd: Work even in established pattern, knitting decrease sts as you come to them.

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Repeat above two rows, 5 more times until 15 sts remain on needles.

Cut an 8" tail and, using tapestry needle, weave through remaining sts, cinch tight. Weave in ends. Finished hat measures 8" from cast on edge to **crown**, unblocked.

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Ripples Hat

Beanies by Beans #4
by Amy Gunderson

Size

One Size
Finished Circumference: 18" (stretches to 22")

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein
Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) and US 7 (4.5 mm)
Notions: Tapestry needle

Gauge

14 sts x 13 rnds = 4" in Post Stitch Ribbing

Pattern Notes

This hat is worked from the top down. A 2x2 Post Stitch Ribbing (**hat body** pattern) provides some stretch in this snug fitting beanie.

Pattern:

Using larger hook, begin with adjustable ring.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: Ch 1 (does not count as st here and throughout), 8 hdc in ring, join with sl st to beg hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *2 fpdc in next hdc; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 16 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, * fpdc in next st, [fpdc, bpdcc] in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 24 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, * fpdc in next 2 sts, [2 bpdcc] in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 32 sts.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, * fpdc in next 2 sts, bpdcc in next st, [bpdcc, fpdc] in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 40 sts.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, * fpdc in next 2 sts, bpdcc in next 2 sts, [2 fpdc] in next 2 sts; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 48 sts.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, * fpdc in next 2 sts, bpdcc in next 2



sts, fpdc in next st, [fpdc, bpdcc] in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 56 sts.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, * fpdc in next 2 sts, bpdcc in next 2 sts, fpdc in next 2 sts, [2 bpdcc] in next st; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc - 64 sts.

Hat Body

Rnd 1: Ch 1, * fpdc in next 2 sts, bpdcc in next 2 sts; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg fpdc.

Rnds 2-12: Rep Rnd 1.
Switch to smaller hook.

Rnds 13-17: Rep Rnd 1.
Fasten off.

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Fish Food Hat

Beanies by Beans #5
by Alex Henley

Size

Adult Small (Large)
Finished Circumference: 17.75" (21.25")
Height: 9.5"

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein
Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular & set of dpns
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 2" pom pom maker

Gauge

18 sts x 24 rnds = 4" in Fish Food pattern

Stitch Guide

WRAP: * Sl next 2 sts to right ndl wyif, wyib sl these sts back to left ndl; rep from * 2 more times, k2.

Fish Food (multiple of 16 sts)

Rnd 1: * K2, WRAP, k6, WRAP, k4; rep from * to end.
Rnds 2-6: Knit.
Rnd 7: * K6, WRAP, K6, WRAP; rep from * to end.
Rnds 8-12: Knit.
Rep Rnds 1-12 for patt.

Pattern:

Brim

With smaller 16" circular needle, cast on 80 (96) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.
Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 until **Brim** meas 1.5".

Hat Body

Switch to larger needle.



Set-up Rnd: * K16, pm; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnds 1-12 of Fish Food patt, 3 times.

Crown Shaping

Note: Switch to dpns when there are too few sts to fit on the circular needle.

Rnd 1: * K2, WRAP, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, WRAP, k4; rep from * to end - 10 (12) sts dec'd, 70 (84) sts rem.
Rnd 2: Knit.
Rnd 3: * K4, k2tog, ssk, k6; rep from * to end - 10 (12) sts dec'd, 60 (72) sts rem.
Rnd 4: Knit.
Rnd 5: * K3, k2tog, ssk, k5; rep from * to end - 10 (12) sts dec'd, 50 (60) sts rem.
Rnd 6: Knit.
Rnd 7: * K2, k2tog, ssk, k2, WRAP; rep from * to end - 10 sts dec'd, 40 (48) sts rem.
Rnd 8: Knit.
Rnd 9: * K1, k2tog, ssk, k3; rep from * to end - 10 (12) sts dec'd, 30 (36) sts rem.
Rnd 10: * K2tog, ssk, k2; rep from * to end - 10 (12) sts dec'd, 20 (24) sts rem.

Remove the beginning of round marker, sl the first st to the right ndl, replace marker for new beginning of round.






Rnd 11: * Ssk, k2tog; rep from * to end - 10 (12) sts dec'd, 10 (12) sts rem.

Break yarn leaving a 6" tail. Pass tail through rem live sts, pull taut, fasten off. Weave in ends and block. Make a 2" pom pom and sew to top of hat.



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Fish Food Hat

Beanies by Beans #6
by Amy Gunderson

Size

Child (Adult Small, Adult Medium)
Finished Circumference: 16.75" (17.5, 18.25")

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein
Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) and US G-6 (4 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, 2" pom-pom maker (optional, see notes)

Gauge

20 sts x 11 rows = 4" in hdc blo ribbing with smaller hook
13 sts x 11 rounds = 4" in Alternating Puff patt with larger hook

Pattern Notes

The brim is worked sideways and slip-stitched together to form a ring. The body of the hat is worked upward from the side of the brim. The largest size may not have enough yarn leftover for a 2" pom-pom. You could make a smaller pom-pom for this size, leave it off, or go stash diving!

Stitch Guide

Puff: [Yo and insert hook in st, yo and pull through a loop] 3 times, yo and pull through all loops on hook.

Pattern:

Brim

With smaller hook, ch 10.
Row 1: Hdc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each hdc across, turn.
Rows 3-46 (48, 50): Rep Row 2.



Bring the beginning ch edge up to the last row worked. Sl st the edges together in blo, do not break yarn.

Hat Body

Note: The Hat Body is worked in joined rows.

Set-up rnd (RS): Ch 1, work 60 (64, 68) sc evenly along side of Brim, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Begin Pattern

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 1, [hdc in next 3 sts, Puff in next st] to end, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 1, hdc in each st around, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [hdc in next st, Puff in next st, hdc in next 2 sts] around, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn.

Rep Rnds 1-4, 3 more times.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 1, [hdc2tog, hdc in next hdc, Puff] around, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn. 15 (16, 17) sts dec'd, 45 (48, 51) sts rem.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 1, [hdc2tog, hdc in next st] around, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn. 15 (16,





17) sts dec'd, 30 (32, 34) sts rem.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [hdc2tog] around, join with sl st to beg hdc, turn. 15 (16, 17) sts dec'd, 15 (16, 17) sts rem.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, [hdc4tog] 3 (4, 4) times, hdc3tog 1 (0, 0) time, hdc in last 0 (0, 1) st.

Break yarn leaving 8" tail. Gather rem sts together, pull taut.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block. Make a pom-pom if desired and sew to top of hat.

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Seagrass Hat

Beanies by Beans #7
by Rachel Roden

Size

One Size – Stretches to fit 20–24" head circumference
Finished Circumference: 18"
Height: 9"

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein

Needle: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) 16" circular, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular & set of dpns, or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, cable needle, 2" pom pom maker

Gauge

20 sts x 28 rnds = 4" with smaller needle in k1 tbl, p1 ribbing (brim stitch) after blocking.

Pattern:

CO 96 sts with smaller needle. Pm and join for working in the rnd.

Ribbed Brim

Rnd 1: *[K1tbl, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Repeat round 1 until the brim measures 1.5 inches long. Switch to larger needle.

Body + Crown Decreases

Rnds 1–51: Follow rounds 1–51 of Chart 1, or the following written instructions.

Rnd 1: *[Yo, ssk, (k1 tbl, p1) x 5, k1 tbl, k2tog, yo, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 2: *[K2, (k1 tbl, p1) x 5, k1 tbl, k2, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 3: *[K1, yo, ssk, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, k2tog, yo, k1, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 4: *[K3, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, k3, p1]. Repeat from * around.



Rnd 5: *[K2, yo, ssk, (k1 tbl, p1) x 3, k1 tbl, k2tog, yo, k2, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 6: *[K4, (k1 tbl, p1) x 3, k1 tbl, k4, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 7: *[K3, yo, ssk, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, k2tog, yo, k3, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 8: *[K5, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, k5, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 9: *[K4, yo, ssk, k1 tbl, p1, k1 tbl, k2tog, yo, k4, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 10: *[K4, p1, k1, k1 tbl, p1, k1 tbl, k1, p1, k4, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 11: *[K4, p1, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, p1, k4, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 12: *[K4, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, k4, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 13: *[2/2 RC, p2, yo, sk2p, yo, p2, 2/2 LC, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnds 14 – 16: *[K4, p7, k4, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 17: *[Yo, k3, ssk, p5, k2tog, k3, yo, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 18: *[P1, k4, p5, k4, p2]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 19: *[P1, yo, k3, ssk, p3, k2tog, k3, yo, p2]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 20: *[P2, (k4, p3) x 2]. Repeat from * around.

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Rnd 21: *[P2, yo, k3, ssk, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, p3]. Repeat from * around.

Rnds 22 – 24: *[P3, k4, p1, k4, p4]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 25: *[Yo, ssk, p1, 2/2 RC, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k2tog, yo, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 26: *[K2, (p1, k4) x 2, p1, k2, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 27: *[K1 tbl, yo, ssk, k4, p1, k4, k2tog, yo, k1 tbl, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 28: *[K1 tbl, (p1, k5) x 2, p1, k1 tbl, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 29: *[K1 tbl, p1, yo, ssk, k3, p1, k3, k2tog, yo, p1, k1 tbl, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 30: Repeat round 28.

Rnd 31: *[K1 tbl, p1, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, yo, (k1 tbl, p1) x 2]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 32: *[(K1 tbl, p1) x 2, (k3, p1) x 2, (k1 tbl, p1) x 2]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 33: *[(K1 tbl, p1) x 2, yo, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, yo, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 34: Repeat round 32.

Rnd 35: *[K1 tbl, p1) x 2, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, (k1 tbl, p1) x 3]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 36: *[K1 tbl, p1) x 3, k1, p1, k1, (p1, k1 tbl) x 3, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 37: *[K1 tbl, p1) x 3, yo, sk2p, yo, (p1, k1 tbl) x 3, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 38: Repeat round 36.

Rnds 39 – 40: *[K1 tbl, p1) x 8]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 41: *[Ssk, (k1 tbl, p1) x 5, k1 tbl, k2tog, p1]. Repeat from * around. (84 sts)

Rnd 42: *[K1, (k1 tbl, p1) x 5, k1 tbl, k1, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 43: *[Ssk, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, k2tog, p1]. Repeat from * around. (72 sts)

Rnd 44: *[K1, (p1, k1 tbl) x 4, p1, k1, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 45: *[Ssk, (k1 tbl, p1) x 3, k1 tbl, k2tog, p1]. Repeat from * around. (60 sts)

Rnd 46: *[K1, (k1 tbl, p1) x 3, k1 tbl, k1, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 47: *[Ssk, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, k2tog, p1]. Repeat from * around. (48 sts)

Rnd 48: *[K1, (p1, k1 tbl) x 2, p1, k1, p1]. Repeat from * around.

Rnd 49: *[Ssk, k1 tbl, p1, k1 tbl, k2tog, p1]. Repeat from * around. (36 sts)

Rnd 50: *[Ssk, p1, k2tog, p1]. Repeat from * around. (24 sts)


Rnd 51: *[Sk2p, p1]. Repeat from * around. (12 sts)

Cut yarn and pull through remaining sts.

Finishing

Stitch Guide

Cluster (CL): [Insert hook into sp indicated and
pull up a loop, yo and pull through 2 loops] 3
times, yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook.

Pattern:

Ch 38.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 13
chs, [sc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch] to last ch,
sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), [CL in next sp,
ch 1} to last sp, CL in last sp, dc in next st, hdc
in blo of last 14 sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in blo of next 14 hdc, sc in next
st, [ch 1, sk CL, sc in sp] to last st, ch 1, sc in last
st, turn.



Rep Rows 2 & 3 until piece measures 18 (20)",
ending with a Row 2. Fasten off leaving an 18"
tail.

Finishing

With long tail, mattress stitch beg-ch edge with
final edge of hat. Weave the same tail in and
out of the top of the hat. Gather, pulling taut.

19 sts x 25 rnds = 4" in pattern

Stitch Guide

Long Loop: Using needle tip go through purl stitch from front to back, wrap yarn around needle and pull through the stitch and up onto your needle.

Bobble: (K1, p1, k1, p1, k1) into next stitch, turn work; P5, turn; Sl2tog, K3tog, pass two slip stitches over.

M1: insert needle from front to back into the horizontal strand between the two stitches, knit through the back loop

Pattern:

With circular needle, cast on 80 sts. Pm and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: [K1, p1] to end.

Repeat Rnd 1 for 2.5 inches.

Hat Body

Inc rnd: *K8, m1; rep from * to end of rnd – 10 sts inc'd, 90 sts.

Follow written instructions or Body chart:

Rnds 1 & 2: * K13, p1, k4; rep from * to end of rnd. Pattern will be rep'd 5 times across each rnd.



Rnd 3: *K10, slip 1, Long Loop (see st guide) in first purl st from Rnd 1, move loop and slipped st to left needle, k2tog, K5, slip 1, Long Loop in previous purl stitch from Rnd 1, move loop and slipped st to left needle, k2tog, K1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: Knit around.

Rnd 5: *K13, bobble, k4; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 6 & 7: *K4, p1, k13; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 8: *K1, slip 1, Long Loop in next purl st from Rnd 6, move loop and slipped st to left needle, k2tog, k5, slip 1, Long Loop in previous purl st from Rnd 6, move loop and slipped st to left needle, k2tog, k10; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 9: Knit around.

Rnd 10: *K4, bobble, k13; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep Rnds 1-10 a total of 3 times.

Crown Decreases

Rnd 1: *K2, k2tog, ssk, k7, p1, K4; rep from * to end of rnd – 10 sts dec'd, 80 sts remain.

Rnd 2: *K11, P1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: *K1, k2tog, ssk, K3, slip 1, Long Loop in first purl stitch from Rnd 1, move loop and

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slipped st to left needle, k2tog, k5, slip 1, Long Loop in previous purl st from Rnd 1, move loop and slipped stitch to left needle, k2tog, k1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: Knit

Rnd 5: *K2tog, ssk, K5, bobble, K4; repeat * to end of rnd.

Rnd 6: *Ssk, K8, k2tog; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 7: *Ssk, K6, k2tog; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 8: *Ssk, K4, k2tog; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 9: *Ssk, K2, k2tog; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 10: *Ssk, K2tog; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 11: K2tog around.

Finishing

Using a tapestry needle run yarn through remaining sts on needle. Pull and fasten off. Weave in ends and enjoy.

Beanies by Beans #10

Size

Adult Small (Adult Medium)
Finished Circumference: 17 (19)"
Height: 8"

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) and US Size G-6 (4 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2" pom-pom maker (optional, see notes)

Gauge

20 sts x 11 rows = 4" in hdc blo ribbing with smaller hook
14 sts x 16 rounds = 4" in hat body pattern with larger hook

Pattern Notes

The brim is worked sideways and slip-stitched together to form a ring. The body of the hat is worked upward from the side of the brim.

Stitch Guide

Fpdec: (This is a front post double crochet 2 together around sts from 2 rnds below the current round. The first leg will go in the stitch 2 sts before the next stitch in the current rnd, and the second leg will go in the stitch 2 sts after the next st in the current rnd.) *Yo and insert hook around post of st indicated, pull up a lp, yo and pull through 2 lps; rep from * in second st indicated; yo and pull through all lps on hook.

Bobble: [Yo and insert hook into st, pull up a lp, yo and pull through 2 lps] 3 times, yo and pull through all lps on hook.



Pattern:

Brim

With smaller hook, ch 10.

Row 1: Hdc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, hdc in blo of each hdc across, turn.

Rows 3-45 (49): Rep Row 2.

Bring the beginning ch edge up to the last row worked. Sl st the edges together in blo, do not break yarn.

Hat Body

Note: The Hat Body is worked in joined rows.

Set-up rnd (WS): Ch 1, work 60 (66) sc evenly along side of Brim (about 4 sts for every 3 brim rows), join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Set-up Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Set-up Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Begin Pattern

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sc, fpdec, sk next sc, sc in next 2 sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

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Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sc, Bobble in fpdec, sc in next 3 sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sc, fpsc in Bobble, sc in next 2 sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, [fpdec, sc in next 5 sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, [sc in next 5 sc, Bobble in next sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, [fpsc in Bobble, sc in next 5 sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rep Rnds 1-8, 1 more time, then rep Rnds 1-4, 1 more time.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, [fpdec, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog] to end, join with sl st to beg sc. 10 (11) sts dec'd, 50 (55) sts rem.

Rnd 2 (WS): Ch 1, [sc in next 4 sc, Bobble in next sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, [fpsc in Bobble, sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn. 10 (11) sts dec'd, 40 (44) sts rem.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn. 10 (11) sts dec'd, 30 (33) sts rem.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, [sc2tog, sc in next sc] to end, join with sl st to beg sc, turn. 10 (11) sts dec'd, 20 (22) sts rem.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, [sc2tog] to end, join with sl st to beg sc. 10 (11) sts dec'd, 10 (11) sts rem. Break yarn leaving a 10" tail. Pass tail in and out of sts, pull taut.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block.

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Streamline Hat

Beanies by Beans #11
by Diana Minard

Size

One Size – 18" circumference (stretches to 22")

Materials

Hedgehog Fibres Merino Aran (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/182 yds) - 1 skein

Rnd 4: [K2, p1, sl 1, p1] to end.

Rnd 5: [RT, p1, k1, p1] to end.

Rnd 6: [K2, p1, sl 1, p1] to end.

Rep Rnds 1-6 until hat measures 7" or desired length, ending with any odd numbered rnd.

Shape Crown

Note: Switch to dpns after Rnd 1.

Rnd 1: [K2tog, p1, sl 1, p1] to end – 10 sts dec'd, 80 sts rem.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, [dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st] around, join with sl st to beg dc - 48 dc.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, [dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st] around, join with sl st to beg dc - 60 dc.

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in next 13 sts, 2 dc in next st, [dc in next 14 sts, 2 dc in next st] around, join with sl st to beg dc - 64 dc.



Hat Body

Rnds 1-2: Ch 1, bpdC in each st around, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnd 3: Sl st in next st, ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in previous st, [sk next 2 sts, tr in next st, tr previous st] around, join with sl st to beg tr.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnds 5-8: Rep Rnds 1-4.

Rnds 9-10: Rep Rnds 1-2.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog, [dc in next 6 sts, dc2tog] around, join with sl st to beg dc - 8 sts dec'd, 56 sts rem.

Rnds 12-15: Ch 1, [fpdc in next st, bpdC in next st] around, join with sl st to beg dc. Fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block.

Rnd 6: *Work to last st before marker in eyelet pattern, sl 1, remove marker, sl st back to left needle, then k3tog, pm, repeat from * to last repeat, work to last st before round marker in eyelet pattern, sl 1, remove round marker, sl st back to left needle, then k3tog, pm.

Rnd 7: *Work to last st before marker in eyelet pattern, sl 1, remove marker, sl st back to left needle, then k3tog, pm, repeat from * to last repeat, work to last st before round marker in eyelet pattern, sl 1, remove round marker, sl st back to left needle, then k3tog, pm, remove st markers as they overlap other markers.

Continue as round 7 until 12 sts remain.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, * fptr2tog around sts from Rnd 1 [first leg is 2 sts backward, skip 3 sts, second leg in next st], sk sc behind fptr2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from *, ending last rep with sc in last st, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.



Begin Repeat

Rnds 6-8: Rep Rnds 2-7.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, * fptr2tog around fptr from 4 rows down [first leg is 2 sts backward, skip 3 sts, second leg in next st], sk sc behind fptr2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from *, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnds 10-12: Rep Rnds 2-4.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, * fptr2tog around fptr from 4 rows down [first leg is 2 sts backward, skip 3 sts, second leg in next st], sk sc behind fptr2tog, sc in next 3 sc; rep from *, ending last rep with sc in last st, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rep Rnds 6-13, 3 more times, then rep Rnds 6-9, 1 more time.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1 (WS): Ch 1, * sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * to end, turn - 16 sts dec'd, 48 sts rem.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, * sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * to end, turn - 16 sts dec'd, 32 sts rem.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, : Ch 1, * fptr2tog around fptr from 4 rows down [first leg is 2 sts backward, skip 3 sts, second leg in next st], sk sc behind

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fptr2tog, sk 2 sc; rep from *, join with sl st to beg sc, turn – 16 sts dec'd,, 16 sts rem.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, * sc2tog; rep from * to end – 8 sts rem.

Fasten off leaving 8" tail.

Finishing

Weave tail in and out of final rnd. Weave in ends and block.

Brim

With smaller needles, cast on 96 sts using tubular cast on for 2x2 ribbing or long tail cast on. Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

Work in [k2, p2] ribbing for 1.5".

Increase Round

Switch to larger needles.

*[K2, p2] x 5, k2, p1, m1p, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, m1p, p1; repeat from * to end. Pattern will be repeated 3 times across each round. (6 sts



increased. 102 sts.)

Body

Rnd 1: *K2, p2, k2, c2/2R, p2, c2/2L, [k2, p2, k2, p3] x 2; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 2 and all even-numbered rnds: Knit the knit sts and purl the purls.

Rnd 3: *K2, p2, c2/2R, k2, p2, k2, c2/2L, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k2, p3; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 5: *K2, c2/2R, k4, p2, k4, c2/2L, k2, p3, k2, p2, k2, p3; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 7: *C2/2R, k6, p2, k6, c2/2L, p3, k2, p2, k2, p3; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 9: *K6, c2/2R, p2, c2/2L, k6, p3, k2, p2, k2, p3; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 11: *K4, c2/2R, k2, p2, k2, c2/2L, k4, p3, RT, p2, LT, p3; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 13: *K2, c2/2R, k4, p2, k4, c2/2L, k2, p3, RT, p2, LT, p3; repeat from * to end.

Rnd 15: *C2/2R, k6, p2, k6, c2/2L, p3, k2, p2, k2, p3; repeat from * to end.

Work Rnds 9-16 two more times for a fitted beanie or 3 more times for a slouchier look.

Crown Shaping

Rnd 1: *K6, c2/2Rdec, p2tog, c2/2Ldec, k6, p3, k2, p2tog, k2, p3; repeat from * to end. (12 sts dec'd. 90 sts remain.)





Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8, and 12: Knit the knit sts and purl the purls.

Rnd 3: *K4, c2/2Rdec, k1, p1, k1, c2/2Ldec, k4, ssp, p1, RT, p1, LT, p1, p2tog; repeat from * to end. (12 sts dec'd; 78 sts.)

Rnd 5: *K2, c2/2Rdec, k2, p1, k2, c2/2Ldec, k2, p2, k2tog, p1, ssk, p2; repeat from * to end. (12 sts dec'd; 66 sts.)

Rnd 7: *C2/2Rdec, k3, p1, k3, c2/2Ldec, ssp, k1, p1, k1, p2tog; repeat from * to end. (12 sts dec'd; 54 sts.)

Rnd 9: Ssk, c2/2Rdec, p1, c2/2Ldec, k2tog x 2, p1, ssk; repeat from * to end. (18 sts dec'd; 36 sts.)

Rnd 10: Remove BOR marker, [K4, p1, k5, p1, k1] x 2, K4, p1, k5, p1, pm. (No decreases. 36 sts.)

Rnd 11: *C2/2Rdec, k1, p1, k1, C2/2Ldec, p1; repeat from * to end. (6 sts dec'd; 30 sts.)

Rnd 13: *[Ssk, k2tog, p1] x 2; repeat from * to end. (12 sts dec'd; 18 sts.)

Rnd 14: *K2tog, p1, ssk, p1; repeat from * to end. (6 sts dec'd; 12 sts.)

Break yarn leaving a 6" tail. Pass tail through 12 remaining sts and fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block gently.

Rnd 5: {Fpdc in fpdc, [2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc] in ch-1 sp} to end - 15 fpdc, 60 dc, 15 ch-1 sps.

Rnds 6-15: Rep Rnd 5.

Rnd 7: [Bptr in next st, bpdcc in next 4 sts (skipping ch-1 sp)] to end - 15 bptr, 60 bpdcc.

Rnd 4: *C3/3R, k3, p1, k5tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 8: *K3, c3/3L, p1, k5tbl, p1; rep from * to end.

Work rnds 1-8 three more times, and rnds 1-7 once.

Work the final body rnd as follows: [K3, c3/3L, p1, k5tbl, p1] x 5, k3, c3/3L, p1, k5tbl, sl1, RM, return sl st to left needle, PM.



Crown Shaping

Note: Switch to dpns when there are too few sts to fit on the circular needle.

Rnd 1: *K2tog, k7, ssk, k5; rep from * to end - 12 sts dec'd, 84 sts rem.

Rnd 2: [K9, k5tbl] x 5, k9, k4tbl, sl1, RM, return sl st to left needle, PM.

Rnd 3: *K2tog, k7, ssk, k3; rep from * to end - 12 sts dec'd, 72 sts rem.

Rnd 4: [C3/3R, k3, k3tbl] x 5, c3/3R, k3, k2tbl, sl1, RM, return sl st to left needle, PM.

Rnd 5: *K2tog, k7, ssk, k1; rep from * to end - 12 sts dec'd, 60 sts rem.

Rnd 6: [K9, k1 tbl] x 5, k9, sl1, RM, return sl st to left needle, PM.

Rnd 7: *K2tog, k8; rep from * to end - 6 sts dec'd, 54 sts rem.

Rnd 8: *K3, c3/3L; rep from * to end.

Rnd 9: *Ssk, k2, k2tog, k1, k2tog; rep from * to end - 18 sts dec'd, 36 sts rem.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnd 11: *Ssk, k2, k2tog; rep from * to end - 12 sts dec'd, 24 sts rem.

Rnd 12: Knit.

Rnd 13: *Ssk, k2tog; rep from * to end - 12 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.





Break yarn leaving a 6" tail. Pass tail through 12 remaining stitches and fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block. Make a pom pom with leftovers if desired and sew onto top of hat.

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnd 7: Sl st in next st, ch 3, dc in previous st, [sk next 2 sts, dc in previous st] around, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnd 8: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, sc in same st, ch 4, sk next 4 dc, [sc in next dc, ch 4, sk next 4 dc] around, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnd 18: Ch 3, 5 dc in each ch-4 sp to last ch-4 sp, 4 dc in last sp, join with sl st to beg dc.

Rnds 19-24: Repeat Rnds 13-14, 3 more times.

Fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block.

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
