Sizes

Newborn (Toddler, Child, Adult Small, Adult Medium, Adult Large)

Finished Measurements

Circumference: 14 (15.5, 17, 18.75, 20.25, 21.75)"
Height: 17 (19, 21.5, 23.25, 23.5, 25)"

Materials

Madelinetosh Vintage (100% superwash merino wool; 100g/200 yds)

- Shown in Blood Runs Cold (red), Leopard (grey), & Natural (cream) – 1 skein, all sizes
- Needles: US Size 8 (5 mm): 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge
US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular & set of dpns

Notions: Tapestry needle, pom-pom, 7 stitch markers

Gauge

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch using larger needle

Pattern Notes

Hats for the whole family! This adorable elf-like hat is written to accommodate the tiniest of heads to the largest. And each size takes just one skein of yarn!

The smaller two sizes will need to use dpns throughout, as there will not be enough stitches to fit on the 16" circular. For the larger 4 sizes, during the decrease section, switch to dpns when there are no longer enough stitches to fit on the circular needle.

Pattern:

Hat

With smaller circ needle (see pattern notes), cast on 62 (70, 76, 84, 90, 98) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist

Brim

Rnd 1: * K1 tbl, p1; rep from to end. Rep Rnd 1 until Brim meas 1.75 (1.75, 2, 2, 2, 2)".

Hat Body

Switch to larger 16" circular needle.

Rnd 1: Knit, inc'ing 1 (0, 1, 0, 1, 0) st – 63 (70, 77, 84, 91, 98) sts. Work even in stockinette stitch until piece measures 5.25 (5.75, 6, 6, 6, 6)" from cast-on edge.

Decrease Section

Set-up Rnd: * K9 (10, 11, 12, 13, 14), pm; rep from to end.

Rnd 1 (dec): * Knit to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from * to end – 7 sts dec'd, 56 (63, 70, 77, 84, 91) sts rem.

Rnds 2-10 (10, 10, 10, 9, 9): Knit.

Rep the last 10 (10, 10, 10, 9, 9) rnds, 6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 11) more times – 14 sts rem, 2 sts between each marker.

Next rnd: * K2tog; rep from * to end – 7 sts remain. Break yarn leaving 6" tail. Pass tail through remaining live sts, pull taut, fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends and block. Sew pom-pom to top of hat. Run around and cause mischief!

Abbreviations

k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
meas	measure(s)
PM	place marker
rep	repeat
rnd	round
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop
