Materials: 1 10 Yard Kit provided by Jimmy Beans Wool:

Yarn A: Beaded Mohair & Sequins

Yarn B: Beaded Silk & Sequins Light

Yarn C: Beaded Silk Light

Yarn D: Ensemble Glitter Light

Yarn E: Cashmere Glitter

Yarn F: Silk Essence

Yarn G: Cashmere Sock Yarn

Yarn H: Cashmere 1

Yarn I: Ensemble 4

Yarn J: Regal Silk

Needles: Size 5 US (3.75mm) Needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE

Extra needle for 3-Needle Bind Off

Gauge: 16 sts and 20.5 rows = 4"/10cm in Chevron Stitch TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Size: 46" x 4.5"/117cm x 11cm

STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS

k2tog Knit 2 together (dec) - Knit 2 sts tog through the front loops.

ssk Slip, slip, knit (dec) - Slip 2 sts, one at a time KNITWISE to RH needle, return the sts to LH needle in the turned position and knit them together through the back loops, a decrease of 1 stitch

yo Yarn over the needle as though to create an extra st - an increase of 1 st

cdd Slip 2 sts together KNITWISE to RH needle, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over (p2sso).

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

3-Needle Bind Off: Place the sts of pieces to be joined on separate needles, (or each end of a circular needle), hold one behind the other, with right sides facing each other, in LH; with a third needle, (the same size or 1 size larger than used for knitting the pieces), k2tog [one from the front needle, one from the back needle - one st on RH needle], * k2tog [two sts on RH needle], bind off one st in usual manner; rep from * to end. For a decorative seam on right side, work with wrong sides facing each other.

Note: *This scarf is knitted in 2 identical halves from the bottom up, then stitches are grafted together using a 3-Needle Bind Off.*

Chevron Pattern: k1, k2tog, k5, [k1, yo, k1] in next st, k5, cdd, k5, [k1, yo, k1] in next st, k5, ssk, k1

INSTRUCTIONS

With B, cast on 31 sts.

Row 1: With A, work Chevron Pattern

Row 2: With A, k1, p to last st, k1.

Rows 3-22: Repeat Rows 1-2 ten more times first with B, then continue to alternate A and B every 2 rows. Cut A and B.

Attach C

Row 23: With C, work Chevron Pattern

Row 24: With C, k1, p to last st, k1

Attach D

Rows 25-36: Repeat Rows 23-24 ten more times, first with D, then continue to alternate C and D every 2 rows. Cut C and D.

Attach E

Row 37: With E, work Chevron Pattern

Row 38: With E, k1, p to last st, k1

Attach F

Rows 39-50: Repeat Rows 37-38 ten more times, first with F, then continue to alternate E and F every 2 rows. Cut E and F.

Attach G

Row 51: With G, K across.

Row 52: With G, K1, p to last st, k1

Attach H

Rows 53-62: Repeat Rows 51-52 first with H, then continue to alternate G and H every 2 rows. Cut G and H.

Attach I

Row 63: With H, work Chevron Pattern

Row 64: With H, K1, p to last st, k1

Attach J

Rows 65-82: Repeat Rows 63-64 first with J, then continue to alternate I and J every 2 rows. Cut I and J.

Place All Sts on holder or waste yarn.

Repeat Rows 1-50 to create a 2nd identical piece.

Attach I

Row 51: K across

Row 52: K1, p to last st, k1

Attach J

Rows 53-62: With J, repeat Rows 51-52, then continue to alternate I and J every 2 rows. Cut I and J.

Attach G

Row 63: With G, work Chevron Pattern

Row 64: With G, k1, p to last st, k1

Attach H

Rows 65-82: Repeat Rows 63-64 first with H, then continue to alternate G and H every 2 rows. Cut G and H.

Finishing:

Transfer sts from waste yarn to extra needle. Holding both pieces with wrong side facing, work 3-Needle Bind-Off using I or any of the leftover yarns, purling the sts together before binding them off.

Cut yarn. Weave in all ends. Dampen to block and pin out to desired measurements on foam board. Let dry thoroughly before moving.
