

Picot Trellis Bottle Cozy By Monika Evans

Finished Measurements:

To fit a standard wine bottle, 2 lengths are available

Materials:

1 Jimmy Beans Wool December 2015 Beanie Bag, **OR** 5 lengths of worsted weight yarn, 15 yards each, and a 1.5" pom-pom maker

Size 5mm / US H (or size to obtain gauge) crochet hook

Darning needle

Gauge: 4.5 hdc / 3 rows = 1", before blocking

Notes:

Cozy is worked from the top down in 5 different colors A through E, with pom-poms. The Trellis Version is longer; the Label Cover Version is shorter and hides the top of the bottle label.



Abbreviations:

Beg – beginning, ch – chain, ctr – center, hdc – half double crochet, sc – single crochet, rnd – round, sl st – slip stitch, st – stitch

Techniques:

Picot: Ch 3, sl st into base of sc just made

Directions:

Color A – Neck

Ch 3, sl st into first ch to join into a loop.

Round 1: Sc 6 into the loop, sl st into first sc to join. (6 sts)

Round 2: Ch 2, hdc 2 in each sc around, sl st into top of ch 2 to join. (12 sts)

Rounds 3-11: Ch 2, hdc tbl in each hdc around, sl st into top of ch 2 to join. (12 sts)

Before continuing, please make sure this part fits over your bottle neck.

Color B – Increase

Cut color A, join color B.

Round 1: Ch 2, hdc 2 tbl in each hdc around, sl st into top of ch 2 to join. (24 sts)

Round 2: [Ch 4, sk 3 sts, sc in 4th st] 5 times; ch 4, sl st in first ch at beg of rnd. (6 loops)

Round 3: Sl st 2 in next 2 ch, [ch 4, sc in center of next ch sp, picot] 5 times; ch 4, sc into last sl st made at beg of rnd, picot.

Round 4: Sl st 2 in next 2 ch, [ch 5, sk next picot, sc in center of next ch sp, picot] 5 times; ch 5, sk next picot, sc into last sl st made at beg of rnd, picot.

Round 5: Sl st 3 in next 3 ch, [ch 7, sk next picot, sc in center of next ch sp, picot] 5 times; ch 7, sk next picot, sc into last sl st made at beg of rnd, picot; sl st 4 in next 4 ch.

Color C – Trellis Version (longer)

Cut color B, join color C.

Rounds 1-4: [Ch 8, sk next picot, sc in center of next ch sp, picot] 5 times; ch 8, sk next picot, sc into last sl st made at end of last rnd, picot; sl st 4 in next 4 ch.



OR Color C – Label Cover Version (shorter)

Cut color B, join color C.

Round 1: [Ch 6, sk next picot, hdc in center of next ch sp] 5 times; ch 6, sl st in first ch at beg of rnd. (6 loops)

Rounds 2-3: Ch 3 (counts as first hdc + ch), [sk 1 st, hdc 1, ch 1] around; sl st into top of ch 2 to join. (24 hdcs)

Color D – Bottom

Cut color C, join color D.

Trellis Version:

Repeat rows 1-3 from color C instructions.

Label Cover Version:

Round 1: Ch 8, sc in 4th hdc] 5 times; ch 8, sl st into first ch at beg of rnd, sl st 3 in next 3 ch.

Round 2: [ch 8, sc in center of next ch sp, picot] 5 times; ch 8, sc into last sl st made at end of last rnd, picot; sl st 4 in next 4 ch.

Round 3: [ch 8, sk next picot, sc in center of next ch sp, picot] 5 times; ch 8, sk next picot, sc into last sl st made at end of last rnd, picot; sl st 4 in next 4 ch.

Both Versions:

Round 4: *Ch 8, sl st 3 in 2nd, 3rd and 4th ch from hook; ch 4, sk next picot, sc in center of next ch sp, picot; ch 11, sl st 6 in 2nd to 7th ch from hook; ch 4, sk next picot**, sc in center of next ch sp, picot. Repeat once more, then repeat from * to ** once more; sc into last sl st made at end of last rnd, picot. Fasten off.

Color E – Pom-Pom Topper

Use part of the length to make a 1.5” pom-pom. Attach to top of bottle cozy.

Finishing:

Darn in all ends.

Block lightly on a bottle.

Use the remaining lengths of yarn to make 3 or 6 more pom-poms in any color or color combination: The samples have 6 pom-poms attached to all the little tails on the bottom; they can also either just be added to every other tail, or be left out completely.
