

Tapestry and Striped Bookmarks by Ann Wicker

Tapestry Bookmark

Materials:

Color A = Spud & Chloe Fine 7805 Anemone
Color B = Madelinetosh Twist Light Stormborn
C/2.75mm Hook

Abbreviations:

Ch = chain
Sc = single crochet
St(s) = stitch(es)
Yo = yarnover

Notes:

Changing Color

Change color by working your last st before the color change until you have 2 loops on your hook, yo with your new color and complete the st.

Carrying the Yarn

From row 3 on, you will be carrying your unused color along by placing it on top of the sts and crocheting over it.

Pattern:

Ch 10

Row 1: With color A, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. – 9 sc

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, change to color B, sc in next 3 sts, (carry color A along the top of the sts and crochet over it), change to color A, sc in next 3 sts (carry color B along the top of the sts and crochet over it), turn.

Row 4-5: Rep row 3

Row 6-7: Ch 1, sc in each sc across (cont to carry color B along the tops of sts crocheting over it), change to color B at end of row 7.

Row 8-9: Rep row 2.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, change to color A, sc in next 3 sts, (carry color B along the top of the sts and crochet over it), change to color B, sc in next 3 sts (carry color A along the top of the sts and crochet over it), turn.

Row 11-12: Rep row 10



Row 13-14: Ch 1, sc in each sc across (cont to carry color A along the tops of sts crocheting over it), change to color A at end of row 14.

Repeat rows 1-14 five more times (12 squares total). End with 3 sc rows of color A. Fasten off. Leaving a 5" tail.

Finishing:

Block bookmark to 1.5" x 18". Using leftover yarn, sew the button to the first square you made. Place the hair tie at the opposite end of the bookmark near the edge. Fold the edge over the hair tie enclosing the tie. Using the long tail, tack the edge down.



Striped Bookmark

Materials:

Color A = Cascade Forest Hills #10 Red Orange
Color B = Fyberspates Scrumptious Lace #500 Natural
B/2.25mm Hook

Notes:

Changing Color

Change color by working your last st before the color change until you have 2 loops on your hook, yo with your new color and complete the st.

Pattern:

Ch 12

Row 1: With color A, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. – 11 sc

Row 2 -4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5: Change to color B, ch1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Rep row 2 for a total of 108 rows. Alternate colors every 4 rows and carry the unused yarn up the side of the bookmark.

Finishing:

Block bookmark to 1.25" x 15". Using leftover yarn, sew the button on one end. Place the hair tie at the opposite end of the bookmark near the edge. Fold the edge over the hair tie enclosing the tie. Tack the edge down.
