Technique Classes

Continental Knitting

Want to knit faster with better tension and less stress on your hands?

- Skill levels: For advanced beginners to experienced knitters.
 - Materials: Bring smooth yarn for swatching
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Knitting in the Round with 2 (or 3) Circulars

You'll forget all about Double Pointed Needles once you learn to knit hats, socks and gloves on 2 circular needles.

- Skill levels: For advanced beginners to experienced knitters.
 - Materials: 1 skein of Cascade 128 Superwash and 2 16" size US 10 circular needles
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Intro to Sock Knitting

Learn Judy's Magic Cast On, German Short Row Heels and knitting on 2 circulars with a mini sock that will serve as a template for future socks.

- Skill levels: For advanced beginners to experienced knitters.
 - Materials: We will be knitting a small sample that can be completed in 2 hours. Smooth yarn gauge of 18 to 22 sts per 4" (not sock yarn) with 2 16" to 24" needles to match. If you have sock yarn and needles bring them, otherwise we can help get you set up during class.
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Fun Faux Cable Cowl

This interesting cowl introduces a new way to knit faux cables. You'll also learn a new cast on and bind off technique!

- Skill levels: For intermediate to experienced knitters
 - Materials: We used a gradient yarn in the sample. Freia Ombre Grande sport weight (6 sts per 1") on a US 5.
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Tunisian Crochet/Knitting

Try something new with this craft that has aspects of both knitting and crochet. Easy and fast to learn. It is also a good introduction to yarn crafts for younger knitters. This is a technique that is actually easier with two colors and looks good in a variety of yarns.

- Skill levels: All
 - Materials: 2 Colors of smooth yarn in gauge of 22 sts per 4". The Tunisian crochet hook will be supplied as part of the class.
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Spiral Hat Class

Do you prefer to knit in the round with a project? If you do, you might like this versatile bulky hat!

- Skill levels: Advanced beginner and up
 - Materials: Skein of Cascade 128 and 2 US 10 16" circular needles.
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Chunky Cable Brim Hat Class

Ready to try something new? This decorative hat will introduce techniques you'll use on all your future hats!

- Skill levels: Advanced beginner and up
 - Materials: Skein of Cascade 128 and 2 US 8-9 16" circular needles.
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Manchester Scarf

The pretty scarf is chock full of new techniques including a new cast on, bind off, decorative non-rolling edge and matching right and left Showy Decreases. This pattern has over 12,500 downloads on Ravelry.

- Skill levels: Advanced beginner and up
- Materials: Skein of Cascade 128 and 2 US 8-9 16" circular needles.
