### Continental Knitting

Want to knit faster with better tension and less stress on your hands?

- Skill levels: For advanced beginners to experienced knitters.
  - Materials: Bring smooth yarn for swatching
- 

### Estrellita Hat

This lacy hat is a perfect spring project. It includes several new techniques including the cast on, a deep rib, raised lace pattern, and decorative star hat shaping.

- Skill levels: For intermediate to experienced knitters
  - Materials: Smooth yarn, wool or alpaca blend 5.5 sts per 1". i.e. Yarns like Malabrigo Silk Merino (50% merino, 50% silk)

### Cable Sock

This pretty faux cable sock is knit toe up and designed with easy to knit features including: Judy's Magic Cast On, a new rounded toe, German Short Row heels and a pretty decorative bind off. There are no heel flaps, gussets or seaming.

- Skill levels: Advanced beginner and up
  - Materials: Sock yarn in gauge 8 or 9 sts per 1". 2 circular needles to get gauge, 12" - 24" long. Smooth scrap yarn about 5 sts per 1" and needles.

### Spectral Waves Shawl

Love chevron? This garter stitch based pattern introduces a new way to vary the width of the waves along with a new decorative cast on and 2 new increase variations.

- Skill levels: Advanced beginner and up
  - Materials: Scheepjes Whirl, US 5 circular needle, 24-30" long. You may find wood is easier to use with this cotton-based yarn.
- 

### Intro to Sock Knitting

Learn Judy's Magic Cast on, German Short Row Heels and knitting on 2 circulars with a mini sock that will serve as a template for future socks.

- Skill levels: Advanced beginner and up
  - Materials: We will be knitting a small sample sock that can be completed in 2 hours. Smooth yarn in gauge of 18 to 22 sts per 4" (not sock yarn) with 2 16" to 24" circular needles to match.
