Offered Classes

Learn to Knit - For Absolute Beginners

Have you always wanted to learn to knit? This class covers all the basics of knitting in three 2-hour classes. You'll learn how to knit and purl in the continental method, but we'll also talk about yarn, needles, pattern reading, industry standards, and Ravelry. You also add some core skills like increases, decreases, casting on and binding off.

- Skill Level: Beginner
- Materials: 2 balls of smooth yarn and needles that work with that gauge. You will also buy yarn for a few small projects.
- Classes: Intro to Knitting 1, 2 and 3 will be offered several times a month. The cost is \$25 a class and will include some free patterns. Sign up for all 3 for \$60 and take them at your own pace.

Short Rows

Short rows are an interesting way to shape your knitting and there are lots of ways to work them. Includes Long Rows - a new technique.

- Skill Level: Advanced Beginner and Above
- Materials: 2 colors of smooth swatching yarn with gauge of 18-22 sts per 4" with needles to match.

Intro to Sock Knitting

Learn Judy's Magic Cast On, German Short Row Heels and knitting on 2 circulars with a mini sock that will serve as a template for future socks.

- Skill Levels: Advanced Beginner and Above
- Materials: We will be knitting a small sample sock that can be completed in 2 hours. Smooth yarn in gauge of 18 to 22 sts per 4" (not sock yarn) with 2 16" circular needles to match gauge.

Rethinking Chevron

Love chevron? This garter stitch-based pattern introduces a new way to vary the width of the waves with 2 new increase variations.

- Skill Levels: Intermediate and Above
- Includes a choice of two patterns

- Materials: 2 colors of smooth swatching yarn with gauge of 18-22 sts per 4" with needles to match.

Vortex Hat

Looking for that project that works for everyone on your gift list? The Vortex hat is great for guys, gals, kids and babies. Features include a raised spiral that runs from brim through a 2-tiered hat top closure. Pattern includes 4 gauges and 5 sizes.

- Skill Levels: Intermediate and Above
- Materials: Smooth yarn in gauge 16-22 sts per 4". Two 16" circular needles to match gauge. Samples will be available before class and Laura will gladly help you pick yarn. Coming in October: More holiday projects including a shawl and cowl.
