Wildflowers Mother's Day Shawl

Materials: 1 skein Beaded Silk Light or Silk Splash Light
One pair size 7 (4.5mm) needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
Stitch markers

Gauge: 11 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Stockinette Stitch after blocking TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

Size: 18" at deepest point and 45" from tip to tip

STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS

| | |
|-------|---|
| kfb | knit 1 front and back (inc) – Knit next st, then knit it tbl |
| pm | place marker |
| rm | remove marker |
| yo2 | yarn over needle two times to increase by 2 sts (on the next row k1 p1 into the yo2) |
| ssk | slip, slip, knit (dec) – Slip 2 sts, one at a time KNITWISE to RH needle, return thests to LH needle in the turned position and knit them together through the back loops |
| k2tog | knit 2 together (dec) – Knit 2 sts tog through the front loops |
| yo | yarn over needle an extra time as though to increase an extra stitch |
| skp | (left-leaning dec) – Slip 1, k1, pssso |
| turn | switch needles so that your right needle becomes your left, and your left needle becomes your right so that you can continue to work in the opposite direction |
| s1 | slip 1 knitwise with yarn in back |

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

Knitted Cast-On: *Knit into first st on LH needle, draw up a loop and place it on LH needle in front of first st; rep from * for number of sts required.

PATTERN STITCHES

Ladder St: Ssk, yo2, k2tog

INSTRUCTIONS

CO 3 sts

k1, kfb, k1—4 sts

NOTE: from this point on every row increases by 2 sts.

Part 1: Ladder Panels

Row 1: kfb, kfb, pm, k2—6 sts

Row 2: kfb, k to marker, rm, kfb, pm, k to end—8 sts

Rows 3-6: repeat row 2 —16 sts.

Row 7: kfb, k2, ladder St, rm, kfb, pm, ladder st, k4—18 sts

Row 8 and all even rows: Kfb, k to marker, working [k1,p1] into every yo2 from the previous row, rm, kfb, pm, k to end, working [k1,p1] into every yo2 from the previous row

Row 9: kfb, k3, ladder st, k1, rm, kfb, pm, k1, ladder st, k5 —22 sts

Row 11: kfb, [ladder st] x2 k2, rm, kfb, pm, k2, [ladder st]x2, k2 —26 sts

Row 13: kfb, k1, [ladder st] x2, k3, rm, kfb, pm, k3, [ladder st]x2, k3—30 sts

Row 15: kfb, k2, [ladder st] x2, k4, rm, kfb, pm, k4, [ladder st]x2, k4—34 sts

Row 17: kfb, k3, [ladder st] x3, k1, rm, kfb, pm, k1, [ladder st]x3, k5—38 sts

Row 19: kfb, [ladder st] x4, k2, rm, kfb, pm, k2, [ladder st] x4, k2—42 sts

Row 21: kfb, k1, [ladder st] x4, k3, rm, kfb, pm, k3, [ladder st] x4, k3—46 sts

Row 23: kfb, k2, [ladder st]x5, rm, kfb, pm, [ladder st]x5, k4—50 sts

Row 25: kfb, k3, [ladder st]x5, k1, rm, kfb, pm, k1, [ladder st]x5, k5—54 sts

Row 27: kfb, [ladder st]x6, k2, rm, kfb, pm, k2, [ladder st]x6, k2—58 sts

Row 28: Kfb, k to marker, working [k1,p1] into every yo2 from the previous row, rm, kfb, pm, k to end, working [k1,p1] into every yo2 from the previous row

Part 2: Openwork Panels

Row 1: Kfb, k to marker, rm, kfb, pm, k to end—62 sts

Row 2: Kfb, p to marker, rm, pfb, pm, p to end—64 sts

Row 3: Repeat Row 1—66 sts

Row 4: repeat Row 2—68 sts

Row 5: repeat Row 1—70 sts

Row 6: repeat Row 1—72 sts

Row 7: Kfb, (yo, skp)x 17, rm, kfb, pm,(yo, skp) x 17, k2—74 sts

Row 8: kfb, k1, (yo, skp)x 17, rm, kfb, pm, k1, (yo, skp) x 17, k2—76 sts

Row 9: Repeat Row 2—78 sts

Row 10: Repeat Row 2—80 sts

Row 11: Repeat Row 1-82 sts

Row 12: Repeat Row 2—84 sts

Row 13: Repeat Row 1—86 sts

Row 14: Repeat Row 1:88 sts

Row 15: Kfb, (yo, skp)x 21, rm, kfb, pm, (yo, skp) x 21, k2—90 sts

Row 16: kfb, k1, (yo, skp)x 21, rm, kfb, pm, k1, (yo, skp) x 21, k2—92 sts

Row 17: Repeat Row 2—94 sts

Row 18: Repeat Row 2—96 sts

Row 19: Repeat Row 1—98 sts

Row 20: Repeat Row 2—100 sts

Row 21: Repeat Row 1—102 sts

Row 22: repeat Row 1—104 sts

Row 23: Kfb, (yo, skp)x 25, rm, kfb, pm, (yo, skp) x 25, k2—106 sts

Row 24: kfb, k1, (yo, skp)x 25, rm, kfb, pm, k1, (yo, skp) x 25, k2—108 sts

Row 25: Repeat Row 2—110 sts

Row 26: Repeat Row 2—112 sts

Row 27: Repeat Row 1--114 sts

Row 28: Repeat Row 2—116 sts

Row 29: Kfb, [ladder st]x14, kfb, [ladder st]x14, k2—118 sts

Rows 30, 32, and 34: Kfb, k to marker, working [k1,p1] into every yo2 from the previous row, rm, kfb, pm, k to end, working [k1,p1] into every yo2 from the previous row

Row 31: Kfb, k1, [ladder st] x 14, k1, rm, kfb, pm, k1, [ladder st] x 14, k3—122 sts

Row 33: Kfb, k2, [ladder st] x 14, k2, rm, kfb, pm, k2, [ladder st] x 14, k4—126 sts

Edging:

Using knitted co, co 3 sts.

Row 1: K1, yo, k1, ssk, turn; s1, k1, [k1, p1] in yo st, k1—5 sts

Row 2: k1, yo, k3, ssk, turn; s1, k3, [k1, p1] in yo st, k1—7 sts

Row 3: Bind off 4 sts, k1, ssk, turn; s1, k2

Repeat Rows 1-3 across entire shawl. Bind off remaining sts. Cut yarn, weave in ends.
