



## Satellite •

### YARN

#### Thick 'n' Thin Scarf

Granite 961  
6 x 50gm

#### Cowl

Soapstone 966  
2 x 50gm

### NEEDLES

1 pair 12mm (no -) (US 17) needles (for scarf only)  
12mm (no -) (US 17) circular needle (for cowl only)

### TENSION

8 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 12mm (US 17) needles.

### FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf is 210 cm (82½ in) long (excluding fringe) and 22.5 cm (9 in) wide.  
Completed cowl is 20 cm (8 in) long and has a circumference of 65 cm (25½ in).

### SCARF

Using 12mm (US 17) needles cast on 18 sts.

Work 2 rows in g st.

Now work in patt as folls:

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*K2tog, yfwd, rep from \* to last 2 sts, K2.

**Row 2:** K2, P to last 2 sts, K2.

**Row 3:** K2, \*yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to last 2 sts, K2.

**Row 4:** As row 2.

These 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until scarf meas 209 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Work 2 rows in g st.

Cast off.

### COWL

Using 12mm (US 17) circular needle cast on 52 sts.

Taking care not to twist cast-on edge, now work in rounds as folls:

**Round 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Round 2:** Purl.

These 2 rounds form g st.

Now work in patt as folls:

**Round 1 (RS):** \*K2tog, yfwd, rep from \* to end.

**Round 2:** Knit.

**Round 3:** \*Yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to end.

**Round 4:** As round 2.

These 4 rounds form patt.

Cont in patt until cowl meas 19 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Work 2 rounds in g st.

Cast off.

### MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

#### Scarf only:

Cut 36 cm lengths of yarn and fold groups of 4 of these lengths in half and knot through alternate sts along cast-on and cast-off edges to form fringe.

## **Alternate Satellite Cowl Instructions**

The following is an adaption of the Satellite Cowl pattern knit flat on straight needles and seamed to form a cowl instead of knitting in the round on circular needles.

### **COWL**

Using US 17 knitting needles cast on 52 stitches

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Knit

**Row 2:** Purl

These 2 rows form garter stitch

Now work pattern as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*K2tog, yfwd, rep from \* to last stitch, K1

**Row 2:** Purl

**Row 3:** K1, \*Yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to last stitch, K1

**Row 4:** Purl

These 4 rows form pattern

Continue in pattern until cowl measures 19 cm (approx. 7.5 inches), ending with RS facing for next row

Work 2 rounds garter stitch

Cast off.

Block the cowl flat, then seam edges together to form the cowl. Weave in ends.
