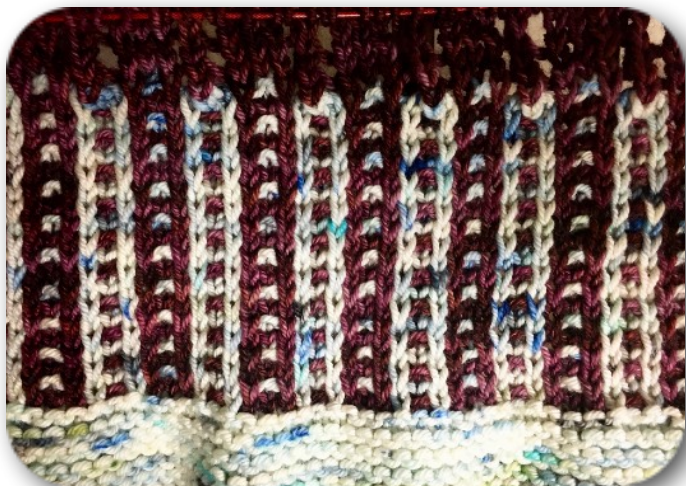




# Unraveled Designs and Yarn

## Semi-Precious Tosh Blanket KAL 2017



### Gauge

17 stitches and 36 rows = 4 inches in garter stitch, unblocked. Gauge is not critical!

### Glossary

k: knit  
p: purl  
sl: slip stitch(es) purl-wise  
wyib: with working yarn held toward the back of the work  
wyif: with working yarn held toward the front of the work  
yo: yarn over  
s2kp2: Slip 2 stitches together knit-wise, k1, pass 2 slipped stitches over.

### Measurements

Approximately 55" Wide x 60" Long

### Materials

Worsted Weight yarn - 200 yards of 12 different colors. Recommended yarn is Madelinetosh Tosh Vintage from the 2017 Semi-Precious Tosh collection at [Jimmy Beans Wool](#).

US 7-40" (or longer) circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Stitch Markers (optional)

Yarn needle

## Directions

CO 209 stitches with Color 1, and knit 12 rows. Leave color 1 connected, and join color 2.

### Section 1

#### Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes

Row 1 (with color 2) RS: k4, \*[k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib]. Repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, k7.

Row 2 (with color 2) WS: k4, \*[p3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif]. Repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, p3, k4.

Row 3 (with color 1): k4, \*[sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k3]. Repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k4.

Row 4 (with color 1): k4, \*[sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, p3]. Repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k4.

Repeat rows 1-4 nine more times\*\*, for a total of 40 rows. Cut color 1.

#### Ribbed Lace

Row 1 (with color 2): k4, \*[k3, yo, s2kp2, yo]. Repeat from \* to last 7 stitches, k7.

Row 2 (with color 2): k4, purl to last 4 stitches, k4.

Repeat rows 1-2 two more times\*\*, for a total of 6 rows. Join color 3.

Repeat Section 1 for the remainder of the blanket, changing color as designated in the Color Sequence.

## Pattern Notes

\*\*Depending on your gauge and yarn choice, you may be able to do more repeats of each stitch pattern. You need about 45 grams (40%) for the Vertical Stripes section, and 20 grams (18%) for the Ribbed Lace as written. Since each color (except 1 and 12) will be needed for 2 vertical stripes sections, a total of 110 grams is needed of each color. To maximize yardage, make sure and save an equal weight of yarn (around 40% of your skein) for the second time it is used for vertical stripes!

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 3

Rows 3&4: Color 2

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 3

#### Section 3

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 4

Rows 3&4: Color 3

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 4

#### Section 4

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 5

Rows 3&4: Color 4

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 5

#### Section 5

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 6

Rows 3&4: Color 5

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 6

#### Section 6

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 7

Rows 3&4: Color 6

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 7

#### Section 7

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 8

Rows 3&4: Color 7

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 8

### Color Sequence Continued

#### Section 8

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 9

Rows 3&4: Color 8

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 9

#### Section 9

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 10

Rows 3&4: Color 9

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 10

#### Section 10

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 11

Rows 3&4: Color 10

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 11

## Directions (Continued)

### Color Sequence Continued

#### Section 11

Slipped Stitch Vertical Stripes:

Rows 1&2: Color 12

Rows 3&4: Color 11

Ribbed Lace:

Rows 1&2: Color 12

## Finishing

Join Color 1 and knit 12 rows. Bind off all stitches loosely.

Block gently, pinning out the ribbed lace sections to open up the yarn overs. Weave in all ends and enjoy!
