**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**  
Approximately 31" / 79 cm wide x  
46" / 117 cm long

## YARN

**BERROCO VINTAGE BABY** (50 grs):  
5 balls #10005 Haze (MC), 3 balls  
#10009 Peach (C1), and 4 balls  
#10001 Snow White (C2)

## HOOKS and NOTIONS

Crochet hook, size 4 mm (F) or size  
to obtain gauge

## GAUGE

1 pattern repeat = 2¼" / 5.5 cm; 7½  
rows = 4" / 10 cm in Lace Pattern  
*To save time and ensure accurate  
measurements, take time to check  
gauge.*

## NOTE

When changing colors at the end of a row, work the last dc until you have 2 loops left on hook, then draw the new color through these 2 loops. Pull up end and secure. Do not carry yarn along the side of work. Fasten off yarn at the end of each color stripe and weave in ends during finishing.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Dc3tog: \*Yo, pull up a loop in next st, yo and pull through 2 loops on hook; rep from \* twice more, working through the next 2 sts, then yo and pull through all loops on hook.

## STRIPE SEQUENCE

Working in Lace Pattern, work 6 rows MC, 4 rows C1, 4 rows C2, 2 rows MC, 4 rows C2, 4 rows C1, 8 rows MC, 2 rows C1, 4 rows C2, 2 rows MC, 6 rows C2, 2 rows MC, 4 rows C1, 2 rows C2, 8 rows MC, 4 rows C1, 4 rows C2, 2 rows MC, 4 rows C2, 4 rows C1, then 6 rows MC.

## THROW

With MC, ch 158.

**Set Up Row:** Dc into 3rd ch from hook, ch 1, skip next ch, dc into next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [dc, ch 1, dc] all in next ch, ch 3, [dc, ch 1, dc] all into next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, \* skip next ch, dc3tog over next 3 ch, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [dc, ch 1, dc] all in next ch, ch 3, [dc, ch1, dc] all in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1; rep from \* to last 4 ch, [skip next ch, dc in next ch] twice, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, skip first 2 dc, [dc in next dc, ch 1] twice, skip next dc, [dc, ch 1, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc] all in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, \* dc3tog over next ch, top of next dc3tog, and next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next dc, [dc, ch 1, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 1, dc] all in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* to last 2 dc, dc in each of the last 2 dc, turn.

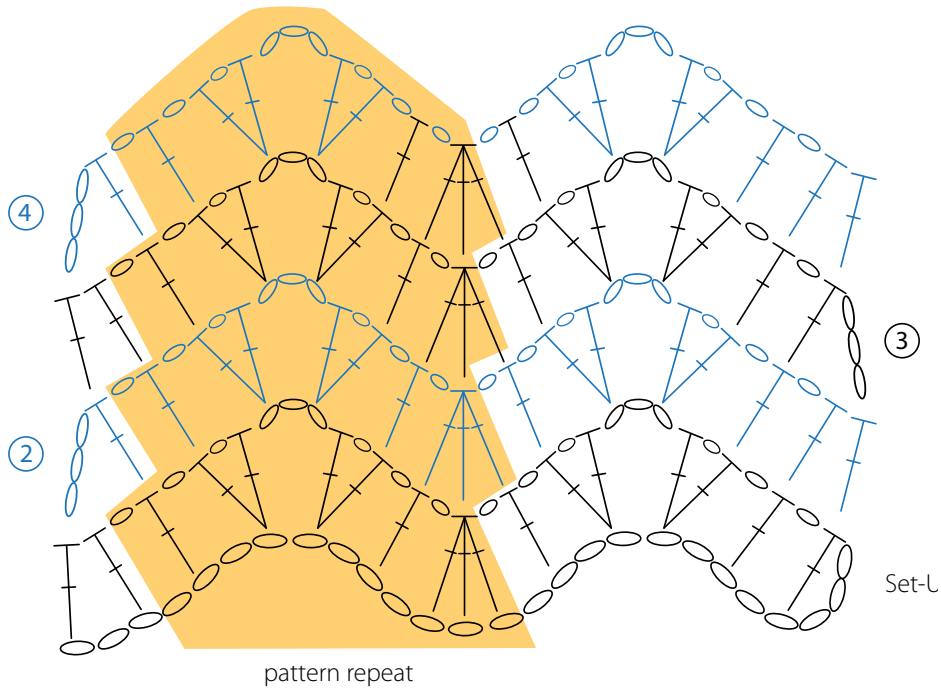
Rep Row 2 for Lace Pattern, beginning with 3rd row of Stripe Sequence and following Stripe Sequence to end. When Stripe Sequence has been completed, fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**beg:** beginning

**CC:** contrasting color

**cont:** continue

**ch:** chain

**dec:** decrease

**dc:** double crochet

**dtr:** double treble crochet

**est:** established

**hdc:** half double crochet

**inc:** increase

**MC:** main color

**pat(s):** pattern(s)

**pm:** place marker

**rep:** repeat

**rnd(s):** round(s)

**RS:** right side

**sc:** single crochet

**sl st:** slip stitch

**sliding loop:** Form a loop of yarn around your fingers, with the end attached to the ball on the right and the tail on the left. Insert hook into the loop under both pieces of yarn and draw up a loop onto hook. (This does not count as your first stitch.) Work first row into the original loop. Pull up the yarn tail after your first row is complete to close the loop.

**sp:** space

**st(s):** stitch(es)

**tog:** together

**tr:** treble

**WS:** wrong side

**yo:** yarn over
