Chrysalis Cowl

One hank of Tosh Vintage is all it takes to knit this beautiful cowl! The pattern is easy to memorize with subtle lace details that give the Chrysalis Cowl a slouchy fit and an air of elegance all in one. With well over 100 hand-dyed colorways to choose from it is all too easy to create a one-of-a-kind neck warmer that compliments your personal style!



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SIZE: This piece is intended to be worn loose and slouchy.

YARN: Madelinetosh, Tosh Vintage (1) 200 yd skein, shown in Winter Wheat colorway.

NEEDLES: US8 (5mm) 16" circular or size needed to obtain gauge.

NOTIONS: Blunt needle for weaving in ends. One stitch marker.

GAUGE: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" inches in stockinette stitch (stst) on US8 (5mm) needle or size needed to obtain gauge.

Abbreviations: K = knit K2tog = knit 2 together
YO = yarn over

NOTES: This cowl is worked in the round and fully reversible. You can work additional pattern repeats to make your cowl longer in length.

For a cowl to wear doubled around your neck cast on 180 sts instead of 90 and work the six pattern repeats as listed above.

Directions: Cast on 90 stitches, place marker and join for knitting in the round. Work 6 rounds purling each stitch around to end.

Pattern repeat: Rnds 1-6: Knit to end of rnd.

Rnd 7: Purl to end of rnd.

Rnd 8: Knit to end of rnd.

Rnd 9: Purl to end of rnd.

Rnd 10: *K2tog, YO, repeat from * to last stitch, K last stitch.

Rnd 11: Purl to end of rnd.

Rnd 12: Knit to end of rnd.

Rnd 13: Purl to end of rnd.

Repeat rounds 1-13 six times more for a total of six pattern repeats. Work 6 rounds purling each stitch around to end. Cast off all sts.

FINISHING: Cut a 6 inch tail and weave in end along the bottom edge of the cowl for a neat finish on both front and back of the finished fabric. Block lightly if desired for a looser fit around the neck.

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
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
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
