

Official Stitch Mountain Pattern:

Snowboarder's Head Band

For Jimmy Beans Wool (<http://jimmybeanswool.com>)

Yarn:

Red Heart® Washable Ewe™ 1 ball 3706 Zinnia or 3430 Kitten

Approximate Finished Size After Blocking:

20" circumference (stretches to fit 22" head)

Gauge:

K20 sts and 40 rows = 4 inches/10cm in

Garter st (knit every row)

To save time, take time to check gauge

Supplies:

Knitting needles: 4mm [Us 6]

Yarn needle

Skill Level: Beginner

Abbreviations:

K = knit

mm = millimeters

st(s) = stitch (es)

tog = together

* or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.

Note:

Headband is knit in a strip with a seam at the back of the head.

DIRECTIONS:

Cast on 18 sts.

Rows 1-18: Knit.

Row 19: Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Rows 20-28: Knit.

Repeat Rows 19-28 six more times – 11 sts remain.

Knit 36 rows.

Next Row: *Knit to last 2 sts, knit into front and back of next st, k1.

Knit 9 rows.

Repeat from * 6 more times – 18 sts.

Knit 18 rows. Bind off. Sew cast on edge to bound off edge.
