Snowboarder's Throw

For Jimmy Beans Wool (<http://jimmybeanswool.com>)

Yarn:

Red Heart® Soft™: 4 balls 4600 white A, 3 balls 9925 Really Red B, 2 balls each 9820 mid blue C, and 4604 navy D.

Approximate Finished Size After Blocking:

K45" wide x 60" long

Gauge:

18 sts = 4"; 15 rows = 3.75" in pattern one square measures about 8.25 x 8.25"

CHECK YOUR GAUGE

Use any size needles to obtain the gauge

Supplies:

5mm [Us H-8] crochet Hook

4mm [Us G-6] crochet Hook (for last border round only)

Yarn needle

Skill Level: Beginner

Abbreviations:

a, b, c, and d = color A, B, C, and D

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

* or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated

[] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified

() = work directions in parentheses into same stitch.

NOTES

1. Throw is made from 35 squares. each square contains 5 stripes of color. 17 squares have 5 vertical stripes, and 18 squares have 5 horizontal stripes. squares are arranged into 7 rows of 5 squares each.
2. For beginner crocheters: make 18 of square #1 and 17 of square #2 and then sew them together first in rows and then sew the rows together. Then you will go on to following instructions for the Border.
3. For intermediate crocheters: you may choose to use the "join as you go" technique explained in the pattern. This reduces the amount of assembly needed. If you are a right-handed crocheter, the

stripes and squares are joined to the right of the previous stripe or square. When joining a new color, always begin with the Right side facing.

SQUARE #1

Stripe #1

With larger hook and d, ch 38. note: work all squares using larger hook.

Row 1 (Right side): working in back bars, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across, turn—19 sc and 18 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 2–5: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn.

Fasten off.

Stripe #2

Row 6 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of a in first sc of last row, ch 1, sc in same sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn.

Rows 7–12: Repeat Row 2 six times. Fasten off.

Stripe #3

Row 13 (Right side): with b, work same as Row 6.

Rows 14–21: Repeat Row 2 eight times. Fasten off.

Stripe #4

Row 22 (Right side): with a, work same as Row 6.

Rows 23–28: Repeat Row 2 six times. Fasten off.

Stripe #5

Row 29 (Right side): with c, work same as Row 6.

Rows 30–33: Repeat Row 2 four times. Fasten off.

SQUARE #2

Note: For right-handed crocheters, square #2 is worked and joined to the right of square #1.

Stripe #1

With Right side facing, draw up a loop of d in ch at base of first sc of Row 1 of square #1 (first ch made), ch 6 more (for a total of 7 chains worked with d).

Row 1 (Right side): working in back bars, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across, skip last ch, slip st in top of Row 1 of square #1, turn—3 sc, and 2 ch-1 spaces.

Row 2: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 3: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, slip st in top of Row 3 of square #1, turn.

Rows 4–33: Repeat last 2 rows 15 more times, joining ends of all odd-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in square #1. Fasten off.

Stripe #2

Note: For right-handed crocheters, stripe #2 is worked and joined to the right of stripe #1.

With Right side facing, draw up a loop of a in ch at base of first sc of Row 1 of stripe #1 (first ch made), ch 8 more (for a total of 9 chains worked with a), turn.

Row 1 (Right side): working in back bars, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across, skip last ch, slip st in top of Row 1 of stripe #1, turn—4 sc, and 3 ch-1 spaces.

Row 2: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 3: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, slip st in top of Row 3 of stripe #1, turn.

Rows 4–33: Repeat last 2 rows 15 more times, joining ends of all odd-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in previous stripe. Fasten off.

Stripe #3

With Right side facing, draw up a loop of b in ch at base of first sc of Row 1 of stripe #2 (first ch made), ch 10 more (for a total of 11 chains worked with b), turn.

Rows 1–33: work same as stripe #2, joining ends of all odd-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in previous stripe—5 sc and 4 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

Stripe #4

With Right side facing, draw up a loop of a in ch at base of first sc of Row 1 of stripe #3 (first ch made), ch 8 more (for a total of 9 chains worked with a), turn.

Rows 1–33: work same as stripe #2, joining ends of all odd-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in previous stripe—4 sc and 3 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

Stripe #5

With Right side facing, draw up a loop of c in ch at base of first sc of Row 1 of stripe #4 (first ch made), ch 6 more (for a total of 7 chains worked with c), turn.

Rows 1–33: work same as Rows 1–33 of stripe #2, joining ends of all odd-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in previous stripe—3 sc and 2 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

SQUARE #3

Stripe #1

With Right side facing, draw up a loop of d in ch at base of first sc of Row 1 of square #2 (first ch made), ch 38 more (for a total of 39 chains worked with d).

Rows 1–5: work same as Rows 1–5 of stripe #1 of square #2, joining ends of all odd-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in square #2—19 sc and 18 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

Stripe #2

Row 6 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of d, in first sc of last row of stripe #1, ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, slip st in top of Row 6 of square #2, turn.

Row 7: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 8: ch 1, sc in first st, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, slip st in top of Row 8 of square #2, turn.

Rows 9–12: Repeat last 2 rows, joining ends of all even-numbered rows with a slip st in top of corresponding row in previous square, turn. Fasten off.

Stripe #3

Row 13 (Right side): with b, work same as Row 6.

Rows 14–21: Repeat Row 2 eight times. Fasten off.

Stripe #4

Row 22 (Right side): with a, work same as Row 6.

Rows 23–28: Repeat Row 2 six times. Fasten off.

Stripe #5

Row 29 (Right side): with c, work same as Row 6.

Rows 30–33: Repeat Row 2 four times. Fasten off.

SQUARE #4

Work same as square #2, joining to square #3.

SQUARE #5

Work same as square #3, joining to square #4.

SQUARE #6

Note: square #6 is the first square in the 2nd row of squares and is worked on top of square #1.

Stripe #1

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of d in 17th sc (33rd st) of last row of square #1, ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * to end of square #1, turn—3 sc, and 2 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 2–33: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn. Fasten off.

Stripe #2

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of a in 13th sc (25th st) of last row of square #1, ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next st] 3 times; slip st in top of Row 1 of stripe #1, turn—4 sc and 3 ch-1 spaces.

Continuing with a, complete same as stripe #2 of square #2. Fasten off.

Stripe #3

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of b in 8th sc (15th st) of last row of square #1, ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next st] 4 times; slip st in top of Row 1 of stripe #2, turn—5 sc and 4 ch-1 spaces.

Continuing with b, complete same as stripe #2. Fasten off.

Stripe #4

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of a in 4th sc (7th st) of last row of square #1, ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next st] 3 times; slip st in top of Row 1 of stripe #3, turn—4 sc and 3 ch-1 spaces.

Continuing with a, complete same as stripe #2. Fasten off.

Stripe #5

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of c in first sc of last row of square #1, ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next st] 2 times; slip st in top of Row 1 of stripe #3, turn—3 sc and 2 ch-1 spaces.

Continuing with a, complete same as stripe #2. Fasten off.

SQUARE #7

Note: square #7 is worked across the top of square #2, and joined to square #6.

Stripe #1–#5

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of d in first st of last row of square #2, ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space or joining seam, sc in next sc; repeat from * all the way across top of square #6, slip st in top of Row 1 of square #6, turn—13 sc, and 12 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 2–33: work same as Rows 2–33 of square #3, joining to square #6. Fasten off.

SQUARE #8

Note: square #8 is worked across the top of square #3, and joined to square #7.

Stripe #1

Row 1 (Right side): with Right side facing, draw up a loop of d in 17th sc (33rd st) of last row of square #3, ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * to end of square #3, slip st in top of Row 1 of square #7, turn—3 sc, and 2 ch-1 spaces.

Rows 2–33: ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn. Fasten off.

Stripes #2–#5

Work same as stripes #2–5 of square #6, beginning each stripe across top of square #3.

SQUARE #9

Work same as square #7, working across top of square #4, and joining to square #8.

SQUARE #10

Work same as square #8, working across the top of square # 5, and joining to square #9.

SQUARES #11–#15

Work in same manner as squares #1–#5, working the first row of each square across the top of the squares in the previous row of squares.

SQUARES #16–#20

Work in same manner as squares #6–#10, working the first row of each square across the top of the squares in the previous row of squares.

SQUARES #21–#25

Work in same manner as squares #1–#5, working the first row of each square across the top of the squares in the previous row of squares.

SQUARES #26–#30

Work in same manner as squares #6–#10, working the first row of each square across the top of the squares in the previous row of squares.

SQUARES #31–#35

Work in same manner as squares #1–#5, working the first row of each square across the top of the squares in the previous row of squares.

BORDER

With right side facing and larger hook, draw up a loop of c in left side edge, in last row of last b-colored stripe.

Round 1 (Right side): working down left side edge, ch 1, sc in end of each row to corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; working across opposite side of foundation chains, sc in each ch (at base of sc) and in each ch-1 space across to corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; sc in each of each row up right side edge, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; working across top of throw, sc in each sc and in each ch-1 space across to corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner; working down remainder of left side edge, sc in end of each row to end of round; join with slip st in first sc.

Round 2 (Right side): ch 1, sc in same sc as join, [ch 1, *skip next sc, sc in next st, ch 1; repeat from * to next corner ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space] 4 times, ch 1, **skip next sc, sc in next sc, ch 1; repeat from ** to end of round; join with slip st in first sc, turn. notes: at some corners, you will skip a stitch before working into the ch-2 space, at other corners there will be no stitch to skip before working into the ch-2 space.

In all cases, ensure that you work a ch-1 before and after each corner (sc, ch 2, sc).

Round 3 (wrong side): ch 1, [*sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from * to next corner ch-2 space, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space, ch 1, skip next sc] 4 times **sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, skip next sc; repeat from ** to end of round; join with slip st in first sc, turn.

Round 4 (Right side): Repeat Round 3. Fasten off.

With wrong side facing, draw up a loop of d in any ch-1 space (away from a corner).

Round 5 (wrong side): with d, repeat Round 3.

Change to smaller hook.

Round 6 (Right side): ch 1, skipping all sc sts, work (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-1 space around, working (sc, ch 4, sc) in each corner ch-2 space; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. With wrong side facing, block lightly.
