

My Mountain Diamond Peak Hat

Materials:

- Schachenmayr original Lumio, 1 ball [150g] (shown in #00035 Neon Pink or #00054 Capri)
- Set of 5 US 15 [10mm] double-pointed needles, or size to obtain gauge.
- Stitch marker.
- Tapestry needle.

Size:

Approximately 20½"–21¼" [52–54cm] Circumference

Gauge:

8 stitches and 12 rounds = 4" [10cm] in the rib pattern.

Rib Pattern: (multiple of 4 stitches)

Round 1: *Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from * around. Repeat round 1 for the pattern.

***Note:** This hat is worked in the round from the bottom up.

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INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 40 stitches.

Divide stitches evenly over 4 needles, with 10 stitches on each needle. Place marker for the beginning of the round, and join to work in rounds.

Begin the Rib Pattern and work until piece measures 7¾" [19.5cm].

Shape top

Next (decrease) round: *Knit 2, knit 2 together; repeat from * around – 30 stitches.

Next round: *Knit 2, purl 1; repeat from * around.

Next (decrease) round: *Knit 2 together, purl 1; repeat from * around – 20 stitches.

Next round: *Knit 1, purl 1; repeat from * around.

Next round: *Knit 2 together; repeat from * around – 10 stitches.

Cut yarn. Thread cut end through a tapestry needle and draw the yarn through the remaining stitches twice. Pull tight to gather the top of the hat. Fasten securely on the inside.

Hat measures 9½" [24cm] tall.

Finishing:

Weave in the ends. Make a pompom 3¼" [8cm] in diameter. Sew the pompom to the top of the hat.
