

Scarves to Throws - Month 7 - Free Knitting Pattern

Designed by Rachel, this is an easy and fast lace/bobble pattern that will knit quickly, but still be fun!

Finished Measurements: 5.5 x 65 inches

Materials:

1 ball of Lornas Laces Shepherd Worsted in Glenwood
Straight knitting needles, US size 10

Gauge: Not super important...

Abbreviations:

MB = Make Bobble: In next st [k1, p1, k1] in the same st to create three stitches from one. Turn work and purl 3. Turn work and knit 3. Turn work and purl 3. Turn work and knit 3 together.

K: knit

P: purl

k2tog - knit 2 together

yo - yarn over

Directions:

Cast on 23 stitches

Set Up Row (ws): p23

Row 1(rs): k3, *MB, k3; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2,4,6,8,10,12,14: p23

Row 3,5,7,9,11: k1, *yo, k2tog; repeat from * to end of row.

Row 13: k23

Row 14: Purl to end of row.

Repeat rows 1 thru 14 a total of 17 times, end scarf by repeating Rows 1 and 2, bind off in knit st on next rs row.

Weave in ends, and block to 65 inches long.
