

## Scarves to Throws – Month 7

For Jimmy Beans Wool

Designed by Rachel, this is an easy and fast lace/bobble pattern that will knit quickly, but still be fun!



**Finished Measurements:** 5 1/2 x 65 inches

### Materials

- 1 ball of Lornas Laces Shepherd Worsted in Glenwood
- Straight knitting needles, US size 10

### Gauge

- Not super important...

### Abbreviations

- MB = Make Bobble: In next st [k1, p1, k1] in the same st to create three stitches from one. Turn work and purl 3. Turn work and knit 3. Turn work and purl 3. Turn work and knit 3 together.
- K: knit
- P: purl
- k2tog - knit 2 together
- yo - yarn over

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## Directions

- Cast on 23 stitches
- Set Up Row (ws): p23
- Row 1(rs): k3, \*MB, k3; repeat from \* to end of row.
- Row 2,4,6,8,10,12,14: p23
- Row 3,5,7,9,11: k1, \*yo, k2tog; repeat from \* to end of row.
- Row 13: k23
- Row 14: Purl to end of row.
  
- Repeat rows 1 thru 14 a total of 17 times, end scarf by repeating Rows 1 and 2, bind off in knit st on next rs row.
- Weave in ends, and block to 65 inches long.

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
