

## Tao Silk and Parisienne Scarf

For Jimmy Beans Wool (<http://jimmybeanswool.com>)

**Finished Measurements:** 6 1/2 x 86 inches

### Materials

- 1 ball of Colinette Parisienne in 163 Vincent's Apron
- 2 balls of Colinette Tao Silk in 163 Vincent's Apron
- Straight knitting needles, US size 9

### Gauge

- Not super important...

### Abbreviations

- rs: Right Side
- ws: Wrong Side
- K: knit
- P: purl
- K2TOG: knit 2 stitches together, as if they were one.
- PSSO: pass slipped stitch over.
- YO: yarn-over

### Directions

- Holding 1 strand each of the Tao Silk and the Parisienne together, CO 28 sts
- Row 1(rs): K2, \*K3, YO, SL 1, K2TOG, PSSO, YO; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, K2
- Row 2 & 4 (ws): Purl
- Row 3: K2, \*YO, SL 1, K2TOG, PSSO, YO, K3; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, K2
- Repeat rows 1-4 until scarf measures about 85 inches unblocked (or until you only have enough yarn for 1 more row). BO all stitches.

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
