

Tao Silk Scarf

When the Tao Silk and Parisienne arrived, I knew I had to do something special with it! I started a custom scarf - and am almost done...

Finished Measurements: 6 1/2 x 86 inches

Materials

- 1 ball of [Colinette Parisienne](#) in 163 Vincent's Apron
- 2 balls of [Colinette Tao Silk](#) in 163 Vincent's Apron
- [Straight knitting needles, US size 9](#)

Gauge

- Not super important...

Abbreviations

- rs: Right Side
- ws: Wrong Side
- K: knit
- P: purl
- K2TOG: knit 2 stitches together, as if they were one.
- PSSO: pass slipped stitch over.
- YO: yarn-over
- Directions
- Holding 1 strand each of the Tao Silk and the Parisienne together, CO 28 sts
- Row 1(rs): K2, *K3, YO, SL 1, K2TOG, PSSO, YO; repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2
- Row 2 & 4 (ws): Purl
- Row 3: K2, *YO, SL 1, K2TOG, PSSO, YO, K3; repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2
- Repeat rows 1-4 until scarf measures about 85 inches unblocked (or until you only have enough yarn for 1 more row). BO all stitches.
