

Peruvian Knit Shawl

Skill Level:

Intermediate

Finished Size:

One size.

Finished Measurements:

Width at top: approx 62 inches (155 cm) **Length in center:** 24 inches (60 cm)

Gauge

15 sts and 21 rows in St st = 4 inches (10 cm) Take time to check gauge.

Materials

Yarn Citizen Harmony DK from Jimmy Beans Wool (DK weight; 50% wool, 50% alpaca; 230yds/100g per hank): 1 skein each of Harmony DK in Natural and Driftwood Unity Worsted in Graphite Size 10 (6mm) 32-inch (80 cm) circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle Locking stitch markers

Pattern Notes

The shawl is worked on a looser gauge than recommended for the yarn, to create a soft and drapey fabric.

Move markers up as stitch with marker is worked.

Always work yo's twisted to close up the hole, i.e knit or purl according to pattern into back lp of yo.

Slip sts purl-wise

Let colors not in use, soon to be used again, follow along the side edge, twisting the color in use around the strands not used before starting a new row.

Shawl

With color A cast on 11 sts. Work back and forth on circular needle.

Set up row (WS): Inserting markers in 4th and 8th sts – see Pattern Notes, k1, purl across to last st, k last st.



Row 1 (RS): K2, yo, k1, yo, k st with marker, k3, yo, k st with marker, k1, yo, k2. – 15 sts

Row 2: K1, purl across to last st purling into back lp of yo's – see Pattern Notes, k1.

Row 3: K2, yo, (k to marked st, k marked st, yo) twice, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2. – 19 sts

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: K2, yo, (k to marked st, yo, k marked st) twice, knit to last 2 sts, yo, k2. – 23 sts

Row 6: Rep Row 2.

Rows 7-48: Rep [Rows 3-6] 10 times, then [Rows 3-4] once. – 107 sts

Row 49: With A k2, yo, k1, *k1 with B, k1 with A; rep from * across to last 2 sts, with A yo and k2. – 109 sts

Row 50: With A k1, p1, p yo tbl – see Pattern Notes, p1, *p1 with B, p1 with A; rep from * to last 3 sts, with A p2, k1. Fasten off B.

Row 51: With A k2, yo, k1, *k1 with C, k1 with A; rep from * across to last 2 sts, with A yo and k2. – 111 sts

Row 52: With A k1, p3, *p1 with C, p1 with A; rep from * to last 3 sts, with A p2, k1. Do not fasten off C – see Pattern Notes.

Rows 53-54: With A rep [Rows 5-6]. Do not fasten off A – 115 sts

Rows 55-56: With C rep [Rows 3-4]. – 119 sts Fasten off C.

Rows 57-58: With A rep [Rows 5-6]. – 123 sts

Row 59 (RS): With B and rep Row 3. – 127 sts

Slide sts to other side of needle to work next row from RS.





Row 60 (RS): With A rep Row 5. – 131 sts

Row 61 (WS): With B rep Row 2.

Slide sts to other side of needle to work next row from WS.

Row 62 (WS): With A k1, purl across to last st, k1.

Row 63 (RS): With A rep Row 3. Fasten off A . – 135 sts. Slide sts to other side of needle to work next row from RS.

Rows 64-65: With C rep [Rows 5-6]. – 139 sts

Remove markers.

Row 66 (RS): With C k2, yo, k2, *(k1 with B, k1 with C) 4 times, k2 with C, k1 with B, k1 with C; rep from * across to last 3 sts, with C k1, yo, k2. - 141 sts

Row 67: With C k1, p4, *p1 with B, p3 with C, (p1 with B, p1 with C) 4 times; rep from * across to last 4 sts, with C p3, k1.

Row 68: With C k2, yo, k3, *k1 with C, k3 with B, k2 with C, k2 with B, k1 with C, k2 with B, k1 with C; rep from * across to last 4 sts, with C k2, yo, k2. – 143 sts

Row 69: With C k1, p5, *p5 with B, p1 with C; rep from * across to last 5 sts, with C p4, k1.

Row 70: With C k2, yo, k4, *k1 with C, k3 with B, k2 with C, k2 with B, k1 with C, k2 with B, k1 with C; rep from * across to last 5 sts, with C k3, yo, k2. – 145 sts

Row 71: With C k1, p6, *p1 with B, p3 with C, (p1 with B, p1 with C) 4 times; rep from * across to last 6 sts, with C p5, k1.

Row 72: With C k2, yo, k5, *(k1 with B, k1 with C) 4 times, k2 with C, k1 with B, k1 with C; rep from * across to last 6 sts, with C k4, yo, k2. Fasten off B. – 147 sts

Row 73: With C rep Row 2.

Row 74: With C k2, yo, (k16, yo) 8 times, k15, yo, k2. – 157 sts

Row 75: With A rep Row 2.

Place markers in st number 61 counted from each side.

Rows 76-77: With A rep [Rows 5-6]. – 161 sts

Row 78: With A rep Row 3. Fasten off A. – 165 sts

Row 79 (WS): With C rep Row 2. **Row 80:** With C rep Row 5. – 169 sts

Row 81 (WS): With C knit across.

Rows 82-83: With C rep [Rows 3-4]. – 173 sts

Row 84 (RS): With C k1, p1, yo, (p to marked st, yo, p marked st) twice, purl to last 2 sts, yo, p1, k1. – 177 sts

Row 85: With C rep Row 2.

Rows 86-87: With C rep [Rows 3-4]. Fasten off C.— 181 sts

Row 88 (RS): With B rep Row 5. – 185 sts

Row 89: With B knit across.

Slide sts to other side of needle to work next row from WS.

Row 90 (WS): With A k1, purl across to last st, k1. **Rows 91-92:** With A rep [Rows 3-4]. — 189 sts

Remove markers.

Row 93 (RS): With A k2, yo, k2, *k2 with B, k2 with A; rep from * across to last 5 sts, k2 with B, k1 with A, yo, k last 2 sts. — 191 sts

Row 94: With A k1, p3, *p2 with B, p2 with A; rep from * across to last 7 sts, p2 with B, with A p4, k1.

Row 95: With A k2, yo, k3, *k2 with B, k2 with A; rep from * across to last 6 sts, k2 with B, k2 with A, yo, k last 2 sts. – 193 sts

Row 96: With A k1, p4, *p2 with B, p2 with A; rep from * across to last 8 sts, p2 with B, with A p5, k1. Fasten off B.

Row 97: With A k2, yo, k4, *k2 with C, k2 with A; rep from * across to last 7 sts, k2 with C, k3 with A, yo, k last 2 sts. – 195 sts

Row 98: With A k1, p5, *p2 with C, p2 with A; rep from * across to last 9 sts, p2 with C, with A p6, k1.

Row 99: With A k2, yo, k5, *k2 with C, k2 with A; rep from * across to last 8 sts, k2 with C, k4 with A, yo, k last 2 sts. – 197 sts

Row 100: With A k1, p6, *p2 with C, p2 with A; rep from * across to last 10 sts, p2 with C, with A p7, k1.

Row 101 (RS): With A k2, yo, k2, (k21, yo) 8 times, k23, yo, k2. – 207 sts

Row 102: With A k1, purl across to last st, k1. Fasten off A. Place markers in st number 80 counted from each side.

Row 103: With C rep Row 5. – 211 sts

Row 104: With C knit across.

Rows 105-106: With C rep [Rows 3-4]. – 215 sts

Row 107 (RS): With B *k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from * across to last st. k1. Fasten off B.

Slide sts to other side of needle to work also next row from RS.

Rows 108-109: With C rep [Rows 5-6]. – 219 sts **Row 110 (RS):** With C rep Row 3. – 223 sts

Row 111: With C knit across.

Rows 112-113: With B rep [Rows 5-6]. – 227 sts

Rows 114-115: With A rep [Rows 110-111]. Fasten off A. –

231 sts

Remove markers.

Row 116 (RS): With C k2, yo, knit across to last 2 sts, yo, k2. – 233 sts

Row 117: With C knit across. Fasten off C.

Flounce Edge

Continue with B only.

Row 1 (RS): K2, *yo, k2; rep from * across to last st, k1. – 348 sts

Row 2: K1, purl across, k1.

Row 3: K2, yo, knit across to last 2 sts, yo, k2. – 350 sts

Row 4: K1, purl across to last st, k1.



Rows 5-8: Rep [Rows 3-4] twice.

From WS bind off loosely knitting the stitches.

Upper Edge

Row 9: Rep Row 3.

Row 1 (RS): With A starting in upper right side of shawl, right after the flounce edge, pick up and knit sts inside edge st along the upper edge. Pick up 1 st in every row-end and 1 st in each cast on sts, across to other side, ending right before flounce. — approx 240 sts

Row 2: SI 1, purl across.

Row 3: With C sl 1, knit across.

From WS bind off loosely purling the stitches.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Wet block shawl to final measurements.

approx - approximately

cm - centimeter

g - gram

i.e. - that is

K - knit

Ip - loop

m - meter

mm - millimeter

P - purl

rep - repeat

RS - right side

sl - slip

sl 1 pw wyib - slip 1 purl-wise with yarn in back

St st - stockinette stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)

tbl - through back loop of stitch

WS - wrong side

yd(s) - yard(s)

YO - yarn over
